Prime Hoggs: 2031 Forward SQQ 197p/kg

A yarding of 2000 with 1000 of them in the night before which did help trade. In truth perhaps the worst yarding of Hoggs I have witnessed here since I began with rows of over fat Hoggs or bare stores. An SQQ of 197p/kg represents the absolute break neck demand for export Hoggs in comparison to others. Hoggs today if carrying meat and 37kg to 42kg 200p/kg time after time. In contrast heavies and fat Hoggs today very hard to shift. Weighted Hoggs out in force nationwide and very little hometrade meaning Abbatoirs unwilling to process and kill large Hoggs at all.

Euro Hoggs today well competed for and selling today to 225p/kg for 38.5kg from P Kane, Shipston on Stour with Beltex whilst D J Hull & Partners, Burham on Sea saw the same for 35.5kg. Messrs Kane second pen 222p/kg at 36.5kg and Park End Farming, Crick 219p/kg. Today 427 Hoggs trading over 200p/kg. In the heavies shape and meat rewarded and topping at 199p/kg from John Arthers at 47.5kg with 46kg from IPG Farming 192p/kg and 49kg from Andy Mitchell 192p/kg. In the lump Euro Hoggs to a top of £95 from M J Cheney, Peatling Magna with 45kg Carollais with Russell Keepence, Broadway and M J Cheney £90.50 at 44kg and 45.5kg respectively. Heavies today just getting to three figures but buyers of heavies almost willing the sale to end as they admitted they required less heavy Hoggs than the National Supply. Top £100.50 from Roger Woodward, Stratford Upon Avon at 58kg and H L Goode 60kg to £100 with four other pens from the same home £97.

Hoggs must be clean and of good meat but overfat Hoggs have a very limited audience.
