Heavies in real demand for shape taking a top of 252p/ kg at 50kg for shape Beltex from Pete Batchelor and 252p/kg for Beltex from S Collie, Norfolk and T Edmunds, Cardiff both at 46kg. ## SPRING LAMBS: 779 FORWARD SQQ 271P/KG


Just under 800 lambs today and the first yarding of genuine Spring lambs of the year with guality much improved. Trade really taking off and amongst the dearest in the country for Centres with numbers over 400 and an SQQ of 271p/kg with an avg per head across the whole yarding of £108.50. Todays only limiting factor is a continued shortage of handyweight lambs with not enough under 41kg and some vendors reporting lambs to have done better than expected. Please draw lambs to fit demand which in these early stages of the season will be the Export Markets. In the Euro weights today a top of 295p/kg for Phil and Steph Baker, Bruntingthorpe with 38kg to 295p/kg ahead of J Morris, 34kg at 294p/kg and Hyde Lane Farms 39.5kg at 294p/kg. D & GM Wright showed lambs with bloom to 291p/kg at 37.5kg. In the heavies a top of 270p/kg for a pen full of 45.5kg from David Ofield, Daventry. Phil and Steph Baker again in the money at 45kg to 262p/kg with D Ofield 46kg 261p/kg and SF & AJ Deeming 46kg 254p/kg. Lambs really totting up today to £120 per head in the Export section for 44.5kg from J & S White farms Ltd, Market Harbrough. C D Harrison, Easenhall took £119 at 44kg with Hyde Lane Farms taking £118 for 19 at 42kg. Overall a top for the last pen sold from David Ofield seeing pens full at £123 for 45.5kg and £123 for 50kg whilst JA Boulton made £121 for 50kg and J & S White Farms Ltd £121. Trade really taking off as Exporters move to Spring Lamb sale. One man missing today due to a continued supply of bruised lambs.
