CALVES: 97 Forward

A better show of calves forward than seen here for some time, with trade sharper to match.

Best end continentals finding sharp demand with Limousin x Bulls to £292 from MJ & R Titterton and Charollais x to £288 from GE Pountney. Best Heifers to £245 from RR Barrett & Son. Rearing sorts short on the ground but those forward between £150 and £170 for Bulls, with no rearing Heifers.

Natives a trade dependent on breed. Angus calves today simply on fire with the best end all over £140 topping with a Heifer from P Dyson to £220. Rearing sorts £100-£120 for Bulls and £80-£100 for Heifers. Herefords a neat trade but no where near as dear as the Angus. These traded around the £100 for the better end of the Bulls with Heifers £60-£80.

Dairy Bulls very few and far between today. Best end £35-£40, with smalls £20-£25.

A similar show of calves is expected in a fortnight.

Prime Lambs: 2029 Forward SQQ 204p/kg

Quite simply a flying trade when considering a wet yarding short of too much quality but returning 204p/kg SQQ. A simple case of lack of Supply last week due to the weather and as a result a real trade with long distance Wholesalers travelling down unable to get a start. Best end lambs the greatest in demand and shape and finish rewarded throughout. In the Export weight lambs a top of 255p/kg from local dairy farming Celebs Ed and Emma Hemmings showing 40kg Texels. Long distance travellers from Dover, Messrs Warnock took 251p/kg for 36.5kg Beltex ahead of our very own Norm Deeley with 38kg to 250p/ kg. Messrs Claridge, Winslow took 247p/kg 38kg. Heavies just as well competed with the back log in the fridges seemingly now cleared to see 46kg from Dukes Meadow, Atherstone to 220p/kg ahead of Ben Burtons overnight lambs at 47kg to 215p/kg just beating J Wallis, Blakesley 50kg at 214p/kg. In the lump Euro weight lambs topping out at £107 from Ben Burtons lambs which benefitted from being dry having been in the lairage throughout the night. Hillside Farm took £106 at 45kg and £104 for 43kg just ahead of Obelisk Farm with £102 at 40kg. Weight stacking up today to take a top of £108 for BMF Smith at 63kg for a pen full ahead of Burton £107 handy weights and Humphrey Livestocks £107 for 59kg equal with FJ Tombs at 57kg. Trade very much a welcome treat for Vendors and a tribute to the Supply and Demand changes that dictate the sheep market day to day and reflected in real time through auctions.

Vendors far too many wet and dirty sheep today please now crutch and belly sheep ensuring lambs are presented dry. We supply the food chain and Food Health should be all producers priority. Lairage is open every Sunday until 6pm

Best Ewes in smart demand seeing D Morley, Market Harbrough sell a pen full at £133 others from the same to £119 with Rams from V Manning £118. R Green sold Ewes to £115 with Leek, Staffordshire based P Smith selling Texels to £110. Suffolks to £91 from DJ Farms, Fillongley with most trading in the mid eighties. Mules the highest increase of the week up perhaps by £8 to £71 from R Woodward and £70 from V Manning. Most Mules with meat trading over £60. Again merely a Supply side issue with weather dictating.

Suckled Calf Show & Sale - 8th November

This years Show and Sale, very ably judged by Mr and Mrs Cheaker of Bristol, saw a new improved format and a good showing of quality. Results below. Our thanks to Mr Cheaker for his time and excellent judgment.

The best part of 500 calves through the ring this year to a full but cautious ringside. Interestingly the team of buyers in attendance made up generally from buyers from further afield and new to this market with calves finding there way across into Wales and to the Northern Counties. Trade obviously down on the year but competed for throughout with the hardest hit being the strongest calves whilst the mid range calves trading at perhaps only a £30 discount on the year. Heifers the trade of the day and wanted throughout, many trading at equal rates to last year. We started off well with feeding Bulls seeing 6 months Charollais to £810 from Messrs Bostock, Kenilworth. 12 month old Limousins from B Smith. Wellesbourne took £1000 and a Blue x Bull from the same to £1130. In the majority strong calves seeing Steers exceed £700 and heifers £620 for 7 months to 11 months of age with premiums paid for best shape goods albeit buyers unkeen to purchase cattle needing to be kept warm to face a quick kill in under 90 days, this a real change from previous years. A good annual consignment from Messrs Friswell saw a top of £920 for Limousin Steers at 11 months of age with others £880 at a month younger. Blues to £890 at 9 months and Lims £830 at 8 months. Heifers saw £850 for a pair of Lim x at 10 months with others £780 and £775. Strength from BJ Smith saw £860 for a pen of Lim x Steers at 11 -12 months with others £835 and his consignment of 30 Steers not dropping under £800. Smart Heifers for the seem topped at £865 for a pair with others £845 and £805. MG & M Barnes showed youth with real shape to see 9 month old Steers top out at £905 for two pairs with others £865 to £855 with Heifers to £760. Quality from the Semple Consortium seeing 8 month Steers to £800 for a pen full. Smart Charollais x Steers from Lester Smith Farming to £875 for 7 – 9 month old Steers. Whilst strength of frame from S & J Farming saw 10 month old Steers to £820 with Sisters £790. A good strong trade throughout seeing Steers to average £716 and Heifers £648. A good days trading. Thank you to all involved.


