PRIME CATTLE: 41 HEAD

A varied entry, consisting of a few smart well shaped cattle, but the majority were off grass with an abundance of Herefords and Native breeds present with several over fleshed. The usual company of buyers were in attendance looking for all types but at a price. Demand was there, but several runs have to be quoted cheaper on the week.

BULLS: 3 HEAD

All the bulls were Holsteins, and benefitted from extra customers at ringside and would be 8p dearer on the week. Top price was 144p from Geoff Ratcliffe for a 19 month old animal, others from the same home realized £831.45. As ever more could be easily sold to advantage.

STEERS:10 HEAD

An entry dominated by weight saw demand there for all types but at a price. Richard Fountaine sold Heavyweight Limousin's to £1308.58 followed by Messrs Vernon with Simmentals to £1230.32. Top price per kilo was 186p from the Fountaine Family.

HEIFERS:28 HEAD

An entry dominated by grass fed native breed heifers which met strong demand at ringside. A pair of home bred Limousin's from the Trivett Family topped the section and sale at 213p and 210p, followed by Richard at 202p for a Limousin. Top price per head was £1320 from the Trivetts with others £1278 from G.Hutsby and Sons.

OTM's:2 HEAD

A poor entry in terms of numbers, but not in quality. A non-fabbl Angus cow sold to 114p from Messrs Morley, A Simmental stock bull weighing 1020 kilo's sold to 114p from Newnham Lodge. As ever more are required to supply demand.

Very much the most difficult day of the year to sell Ovine on following the massive Eid festivities of Sunday and Monday Morning. An absolute Bonanza trade the week before purely to serve the Festival and with no other Economic backing. You need only look the comparatively low Deadweight quotes to see this. For this reason Vendors encouraged to only sell as necessary today and despite this nearly 2800 Lambs penned today. Despite the aforementioned again a trade miles ahead of the deadweight, and the highest recorded in the country for the day at 184p/kg SQQ we do not know how lucky we are to have the loyal Buyers we have at hand here each week. Today some lambs included that are barely Stores and Vendors should be aware of the lack of Demand for such bodies in the current sales environment. Draw for meat not weight. Best end Export Spec today still wanted and those of quality rewarded appropriately. Top today R Richins, Oxford 243p/ kg for 38.5kg Beltex with T H Morris & Sons 42kg to 219p/kg and M J Woodward, Lutterworth 39kg to 218p/kg ahead of N Walker, Burford 41.5 and 39kg at 213p/kg. In the heavies trade more subdued but selling to 209p/kg at 46kg from Messrs Richins once again with 48.5kg Charolais from MM Clarke & Sons 192p/kg at 48.5kg and Culworth Grounds Texels to 191p/kg at 46kg. In the lump Euro lambs totting up to 38.5kg at £93.50 from R RIchins whilst £92 for 42kg from T H Morris & Sons whilst N Walker £88.50 for 41kg. Top gross today £97 for 54kg from V Manning whilst R Richins £96 for 46kg and Jamie Whatton 54kg to £96. A hard days trading and likely the trade will slip more for the next fortnight. Perhaps time for vendors to worm and leave stock to catch meat in the coming days.
