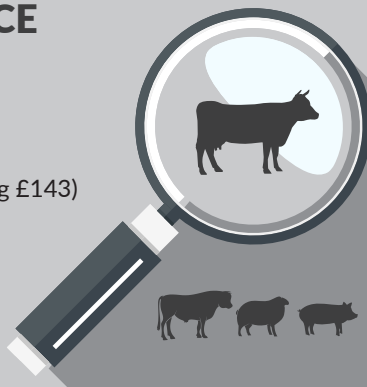

With the Master having performed last week the apprentice returned today with some Act to follow. Trade assisted and an SQQ of 3p/kg with a much larger show of 2400 in and quite an array of quality throughout with a number of leaner Hogs on show. Export trade the driver of the trade Nationally thereafter backed up by a continued demand for heavy Cutting Hogs, whilst the deadweight firms begin unable to Supply this sector with their usual out of Spec Hogs. Top today the magical 400p/kg broken with Hogs to 405p/kg for M & C Morris with Beltex and others 43kg to 391p/kg. J Redfern down from Buxton sold super quality at 45kg in pens of 16 at 391p/kg. Best end Export Hogs regularly 370p/kg plus with lean Export Hogs 310p/kg mark. Well finished Hogs first Mule cross 320p/kg mark with only 44 and 45kg of the second class quality discounted. An all in avg of £144 the real headline with Feeders well rewarded throughout. Heavies remain in large demand and little discount for Hogs weighing 47kg plus. Redferns sold to 383p/kg at 47kg from J Redfern who also sold 50kg at 378p/kg. CR Hill 46.5kg at 368p/kg. Meat regularly 340p/kg plus for meat. In the Lump Export Hogs from J Redfern saw £176 at 45kg for large pens full with 44kg and M & C Morris 43kg at £168 and a returning N F Hodges & Son £168 at 44.5kg. C R Hill £164 at 44kg. Overall no real show stoppers to break the £200 mark but very nearly at £194 with Messrs Wain at 56kg. M & C Morris 53kg at £190 and M & C Morris 50kg at £189. Milkwood Farm up from Newbury £185 twice.

Trade simply flying and very hard to see how sustainable the trade is with Lamb so dear to sell in comparison to White meats and even Beef. A good reward though throughout and meat Hogs needed to fulfil demand.
