A lovely entry today with Vendors from all adjoining counties plus Lincolnshire, Essex and Suffolk.

A pleasure to report the best yarding of genuine finish we have seen for some times with buyers all noting the extra returns for properly finished sorts.

Steers;

Some super finished shaped cattle today start to finish with the top spot shared between GR Fountaine & Son, Buckingham and JW Baldwin Farms, Ipswich taking 258.5p/kg for U grade Limousin x just ahead of handy weights at 256.6p/kg from F A Osborne, Towcester. U- 243p/kg for Messrs Baldwin and Osborne. R Grades today upto 230p/kg and 227p/kg. Messrs Fountaine & Son agonisingly close to the £1800 mark at £1797 with Messrs Baldwin £1712. Heavy weight Bucket reared Blues from Showell Farms saw £1672.

Heifers;

Good genuine meat if no showstoppers, but proper finish and quality throughout topping for U- at 246p/kg twice from F Hodgkin both for weighted heifers and handier shop Heifers bought by Joseph Morris Butchers Ltd and Mutcmeats Ltd. Expertly finished U-/R grades from Messrs Baldwin saw 242p/kg with heavy heifers from G R Fountaine to 236.5p/kg. R Grades all well north of 230p/kg with O+ grades often north of 220p/kg. Is this a trade that is sustainable we must ask. Its nice whilst it is here though. In the lump a top at £1526 from Showell Farms and F Hodgkin £1521.

Bulls;

A nice show of Bulls seeing Mr Consistency, L Smith Farming, Stratford Upon Avon Selling super Charolais Bulls at 664 and 662kg returning £1527 & £1523 both at 230p/kg. Angus from Hull Farms to 221p/kg and returning £1419. More Bulls wanted weekly.

OTM/Cows

A simply blistering trade throughout set off by an over 30 month slip heifer from L Smith Farming seeing a super Charolais Heifer of length and width take 226p/kg and return super £1845 selling to Ralph Pearson Wholesale Butchers, Bradford. Cows again just unbelievable seeing a top of 183.5p/kg for South Devon Cows with Herefords to 171p/kg and plenty of meated R Grades well over 160p/kg. Top grossing Cow to £1400 from DJ Hull & Partners, Essex. Old Stock Bulls from L Smith Farming saw Limousin to 149p/kg and £1583. Cows simply unstoppable and again many more needed weekly with Buyers from Mid Scotland to the inner M25 Circle at ringside.

A good yarding of just 2600 lambs forward and sold to an SQQ that sits amongst the top in the Country with an SQQ of 262p/kg well in advance of a £5.45p/kg DW equivalent. Trade hot from start to finish for a much improved quality of yarding from start to finish. Export Lambs meeting an improved demand and almost all Export lambs trading well past 250p/kg. Best end lambs in demand and selling to a top of 315p/kg for little shape from L Kerby with smart sorts seeing pure Texels from DJ & BK Leadbeater with 38kg to 314p/kg and F & J Clarke first draw of Beltex 310p/kg at 33.5kg. N Walker, Burford selling 39kg to 308p/kg and Messrs Leadbeater 40kg to 305p/kg. Heavies very well followed with Exporters now starting to cut lambs and best end lambs seeing 46kg to 302p/ kg from S & A May, Bromsgrove whilst N Walker showed weight and shape at 49kg to 290p/kg with DS & LE Wadland 48kg to 283p/kg just ahead of E Brain & Sons Ltd. A yard avg of over £110 a truly wonderful result for farmers whom find themselves well ahead on the year. Export lambs totting up to hit £125 for 45kg from G Martin, Warmington. Nice to see R S Whatton & Son here at Rugby to see 45.5kg to £122.50 with Messrs Leadbeater 40 and 41kg to £122. Heavies a smart trade and topping at £149 for 49kg from N Walker with shape at 46kg from S & A May £139. Heavy lambs in short supply but a top of £138.50 for 53.5kg from EJ Taylor & Son and the marvellous Martin Morris, Hinkley 52kg to £137.

Trade very very favourable and a continued boost to the Rural Economy. Two points of interest that must be raised. The EID Festival falls next Tuesday and demand for next Monday will need to be monitored nearer the time with Quarbani generally a festival that Orders are made and filled for in advance of the date. Lean Ewes though taking a substantial slow as a Community moves towards a richer diet during a period of Celebration, especially after a year of Covid. If only we had also won the football..

Top today from DJ & BJ Leadbeater to £169 & £165 for Pure Texels whilst Boulton Bros took £162. Top Ram for the day £161 from RF & J A Nichols. Boulton Bros to £161. And BJ & IS Wain to £160 for Charolais. Plenty of best end Ewes north of £150. Suffolks today to £151 from A Pittom and heavy fatter Ewes from RAE Wilson and A Pittom £140.50. Suffolks generally trading around the £130 mark with only lean and small bodied Ewes falling towards £120 -£110. Mules a flyer for all heavy meated Ewes and big fat Mules a trade we wont see again with Quarbani a rare opportunity to best market these. Top a massive Mule from Hopcraft Bros to £143!!! Others £135.50 from J Baker & Son and £135 from M W Warner. Most Mules trading £120 to £130 for weighted and heavy ewes again very lean ewes very much less on the week.
