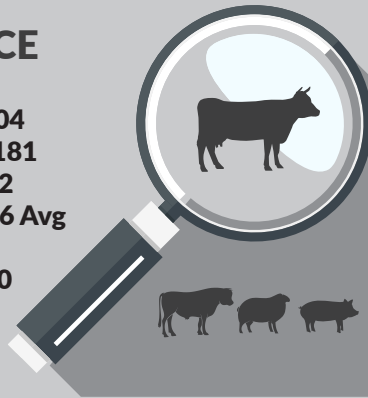

New Zealand lamb heading this way and numbers of domestic kills reported at 50% of December last year. Sales very slow and as a result half the buyers in attendance on a deathly cold day. Trade very hard to sell from start to finish but an avg of 249p/kg SQQ still very acceptable with the massive slow in deadweight offerings. Meat on parade and sadly no reward with buyers keen to avoid taking stock home. Best Lambs selling to 273p/kg at 43kg from P East with lightweight City lambs the only sparking trade and selling to 304p/kg for Slim Laban and 282p/kg for T Gaden at 34kg. Weight lambs easier to sell selling to 48.5kg 289p/kg from M Morris and 270p/kg at 46kg from D G Coombes. In the lump Export lambs to £120 for 45kg from W G King. Overall a top of £150 for 63kg from M Thornber and WH & IM Butcher. Amorise Farms Ltd £146 and £145. All in Avg £112.

Trade very very difficult throughout.
