Bulls to start seeing Dave Bull sell 8 month old Limousins to £620. NJ Wright sold Blue x Jersey Bulls to £600.

On then into the Stores, with younger grazing sorts to start and looking a nice trade. Tom Lowick sold Limousin x Heifers to £900 at 14 months, with Sisters to £800, continuing his strong run. JHB Hart sold super Blonde x Heifers to £900 also at 14 months, before late entries from D Tallis saw cracking Limousin x Steers to £990, £950 and £930 respectively all around the 13 months. Up the ages then saw RS Beaty & Sons selling Simmental x Steers to £1085 at 18 months, with others to £1055. The load of 20 to average £989. JS & N Morely sold 18 month old Angus x Steers to £1000, with Heifers to £970 from the same stable. Sale toppers M & J Smith LTD sold super Limousin Heifers to £1100 at 24 months, with others from the same home to £1040, £1020, £1005 and several at £1000.

A handy enough number for a Bank Holiday but vendors cautious on Bank Holiday which is understandable. Buyers short today due to the day but none the less a trade 20p/kg ahead of the trade in the middle of last week. Todays SQQ 223p/kg a representation of the real demand for Export weight Hoggs with Hoggs under 43kg a fast trade throughout and those under 41kg unstoppable. Heavies a very hard trade as is the trend with no catering trade nationally. In the top three trades Nationally though today including all goods from Herdwicks, Welsh and Swales to Beltex. In the Export a top ppk of 279p/kg for Beltex from R W H Fenemore & Sons with smart pens of Beltex at 45.kg and 45kg from Kieth Crabtree to 264 and 262p/kg with crossbred from the same 44.5kg to 256p/kg. T Head, Kent saw 34kg to 253p/kg. Todays Sqq would have operated nearer to 230p/kg if not for the wealth of Hoggs at 45kg harder to sell. Heavies as ever wanted if shaped and selling to 254p/kg at 48kg from DS & LE Wadland with others 49kg to 249p/ kg and Chris Osborn, Leighton Buzzard equal with Phil Darby Structures selling 46kg to 226p/kg. In the lump Export weights topping out at £120 for 45.5kg from K Crabtree with others £118 and £114. Bailey and Moore 45kg to £109 and young Cirencester based entrepreneur Jack Gilder 43kg to £105.50. Heavies a harder sell with sheer weight hard to sell at Wholesale level with no Catering trade. Shape wanted though and rewarded seeing a top of £125 for Cirencesters best at 72kg with David Wadland £122 for two pens at 48 and 49kg and young Romney breeder Rosie Leach 63kg to £121 producing a sales avg of £93.

Reminder for Cull Ewe Vendors

Please ensure Ewes are NOT in-Lamb before bring them into the market.

THE LAA & DEFRA WANT US TO CONTINUE BUT NEW RULES APPLY

With immediate effect LAA members MUST implement a "drop and go" policy for vendors bringing stock to market for sale. Vendors:

Members must implement a "drop and go" policy for vendors.

This action is to prevent any sellers from entering the market. Vendors MUST be instructed to deliver their animals to the loading docks (remaining in their vehicles) whilst the market staff unload the vehicle and take the animals to their pens. The sale documentation MUST be collected by the auctioneers staff from the vendor's vehicle when they arrive at the unloading docks – Vendors MUST NOT take the paperwork to the market office themselves, or enter the market pennage area for any reason.

The LAA appreciates that this will create many challenges – no more so than developing a system by which the vendor can accept or reject the price offered at the time of sale.

Unfortunately, if we want to stay in business and protect everyone from the virus we need to find and implement solutions to these challenges.

Buyers:

The number of buyers MUST be restricted to allow Social Distancing (2 meters between each buyer). The number of buyers able to attend may be different between markets, depending upon the size and layout of your sale pens and/or sale rings, and will result in some markets being able to manage slightly more buyers than others.

Markets MUST keep a register of those that attend their sales – contact name, address and telephone number.

At the conclusion of the sale buyers MUST be asked to enter the sales office in a way that does not result in too many entering at any one time.

Buyers should be asked to sanitise on entry to the market and again on exit.
