Well this week a lot more finish on the Cattle being displayed and a resulting trade that saw all corners covered and Butchers on top form chased along by another Wholesaler coming from the North to do Business at this ringside. Better finish attracting more Buyers and a consequence returns to suit satisfy the new and old vendors showing today.

Steers:

Plenty of weight on display once again but much superior finish. Top medium weights today saw 298p/kg at 636kg from Page Bros with Blues from this same expert finisher to 290p/kg, 289 at 722kg and 286p/kg and then 700kg at 285p/kg. All U+ Grades. New Customer GJ Burchell, Oxford sold wonderfully long U- Limousin to 270p/kg. R Grades with weight and finish at 237.5p/kg from F Hodgkin with R Grades even those short on finish over 230p/kg. In The gross a top of £2086 from The Page Bros who also sold at £2002 and £1996.

Heifers:

No show stoppers but some wonderfully fed R Grades with real meat on show for the Butchers. Top 277p/kg at U- from Parry Walters with similar goods 274p/kg from Messrs Fountaine & Son. Weighted and super fed R Grades from JD Stephens to 266p/kg with similar goods 253 and 252p/kg from R Ellis & Son. O Grades into the 230p/kg mark and trade simply flying. Top gross £1644 for J D Stephens with £1605 from R Ellis & Son and £1585 from G Hutsby & Son.

Bulls:

A few more about and well received. New Vendor A J Smith Farming, Bedford saw lightweight British Blues to 240p/kg purchased by A J Green, Stoke on Trent. Fed Bulls saw Limousins at 618kg sell to 239p/kg from P Amor whom also sold bothe medium and lightweight Bulls to 229p/kg. Native Bulls saw Lincoln Reds to 210p/kg from AE & AN Tacy. In the gross a top of £1477 from P Amor, Henley in Arden.

OTM;s

A few on show today seeing Limousin Heifers having slipped to 206p/kg from P Jarrom with Angus from AE & AN Tacy at 191p/kg. Bazadaise Bulls to 192p/kg and 190p/kg from AJ Smith Farming, Bedford. Top gross though to the girls with Pete Jarroms Heifers to £1492 and Terry Prestons 40 month Angus at £1268.

Cows;

Buyers all around and meat and finish very well chased with lorries sat on the docks ready to set sail. Good heavy R Grades from Messrs Tivey saw Charolais to 180.5p/kg with lighter Blues from the same 151p/kg and P Jarrom 146.5p/kg. Lean O+ to 135p/kg. Feeding Cows trading 116 to 120p/kg mark. In the lump a top of £1694 for Messrs Tivey selling to loyal weekly customers John Scott Meat Ltd. Those unwilling to feed cows may find a large customer base for Feeding Cows in the Store Sales.

The first point of note being today that the team at RFM had only 700 booked in during the week. Working on sales predictions we informed buyers to expect 2000 and in fact we saw approx. 2500. Please just let us know so buyers can make arrangements or we can convey the current market outlook to you. Trade today much harder with Export orders none existent on the morning of the Sale. New buying faces though and 12 active bidders held the trade upto 284p/kg SQQ which would have been depressed by a large show of 36 to 39kg lambs short on meat and suited to the Export market only. Those with meat and finish selling beyond expectation with all in avg of £123 still a very favourable trade. Best end lambs chased throughout selling to 363p/kg at 38kg from P Batchelor and 39.5kg from R Richins to 354p/kg both pens selling to Pak Mecca Meats, 43kg from M & C Morris saw 347p/kg and 38kg 324p/kg from the Claridge family, Buckingham. In the heavies a top of 334p/kg at 49kg from P Batchelor and 50kg at 332p/kg with R Richins 46kg to 309p/kg and 49kg to 309p/kg with Passmore Bros 46.5kg to 306p/kg. In the lump Export lambs totting up to £149 at 43kg for M & C Morris and 39.5kg to £140 from R Richins. P Batchelor 38kg to £138 and R Woodward to £137 at 43kg. Overall a top today of £172 at 57kg from P Batchelor who also sold at £166 and £163.50. HL Goode & Son £157 for 58kg and 63kg Suffolks from P Batchelor £157. Hyde Lane Farming, and D G Coombes both £156.50. Trade much harder today. Those with meat still rewarded super light Exports weights hard to fix though as the Lockdown's come into place in Europe.
