
Funeral Announcements

The weather did whatever it could to slow the Sale. From Heavy overnight Snow slowing at early morning to blizzards at 9 o'clock meaning some Vendors decided not to venture out. With a delay in start time though we did manage to get most regular buyers through other than the Welsh contingent who where unable to dig themselves out. Another yarding with numbers well up on the year and a full ringside of buyers producing a swift trade once again. Young Cattle a steadier trade on the week with the weather determining a little more circumspect thinking when buying. Best end and grown cattle returning another wonderful trade as the quality Cattle bring added buyers. Another record Store price seeing a top of £1905 for 23 month old Blue Steer from the Family of N Foster.

Feeding Bulls to start saw 9 month old Limousin from S Daly to £1000 and Shorthorns to £995 for yearlings from C E Cockerill & Son.

Bucket reared Calves done as well as anyone can by Mark Peebles. Mark saw 8 month old Blue Steer to £825 and £750 with heifers £625. Next in a Blue Heifer from S Daly saw 10 month old to £1050. The into the first tranche of Cattle sold for N Foster. These quality run seeing an avg of £1265 topping in the younger Cattle at £1410 for Limousin Steers at 10 months and yearlings at £1370. Others saw Blues at 10months to £1310 and £1300 with sister to £1225 and £1175. Next in a first time Store Cattle vendor in Messrs Groves of Oxhill selling Shorthorn Steers to £900 at 10 months and Sisters to £710.

Cornish travelling salemen saw yearling Steers Devons and Simmentals at £935 and £880 and super shaped Blue Heifers at £995 11 months.
