An Sqg of 178p/kg representing another trade in the top few for the Country once again and despite a good sample of lesser sorts out on show. Export lambs now coming forward as wanted and Supermarket accounts in the aisles today as deadweight grids fail to attract numbers. In the Euro lambs a top ppk of 206p/kg for A & R Rothen at 36kg with others 200p/kg at 37kg. PD & DM Hopcraft 199p/kg for 40kg. G R Fountaine 195p/kg to 40kg. In the heavies a top of 186p/kg for 47kg both from R & B Smith and N Deeley whilst Lord Plumb 181p/kg at 48kg and Fountaines 48kg to 182p/kg. In the lump Euro lambs topping at £82 for two pens of 43kg from Pete Incley and R & B Smith 44kg at £81.50. Overall £100 the top for G Bell at 63kg with R & B Smith £98.50 for 59kg and A Tarry-Smith £98 for 61kg. Trade buoyant enough without being off the scale.
