Plenty of meated lambs with 355 over 210p/kg looking well rewarded and perhaps 15p/kg dearer than any deadweight comparison. Heavies just as dear and if not dearer. Top today 224p/kg for 47.5kg from FJ Tombs & Son. Humphrey Livestock 223p/kg for 48kg and 221p/kg for 48kg from SM Thomas. In the lump a top lightweight price of £97 for Humphrey Livestock with 45kg whilst Chris Clayton £95.50 equal with Humphrey livestock for 44 and 45kg.
