CATTLE: 75 Forward

PRIME CATTLE: 41 HEAD

A reduced entry was on offer to a good company of buyers with several faces making a welcome re-appearance at ringside. The entry was dominated by weight with over 50% of the entry above 650 kilo,s. Trade would be sharper in all departments with buyers keen for meat in particular butcher heifers.

BULLS: 4 HEAD

Improved numbers saw 4 men operating, trade would be 10p sharper on the week, top price was a heavyweight Limousin from Steve Abbott which sold to 172p, grossing £1145. Dairy breed's sold to 143p from Mr Ratcliffe and grossed £953.81 for the same. Buyers are requesting bulls every week and more are needed to supply demand.

STEERS:14 HEAD

Entry dominated by weight, saw demand 4-6p dearer on the week with new buyers making there presence felt. Top price was 205p paid for a heavyweight Limousin from The Fountaine Family, Mick Lee sold Charolais's to 194p. Heavyweight's sold to £1447.26 for a tremendous heavyweight Blue from Alan Bicknell who sold others to £1350.00. Messrs Caswell sold Simmentials to £1333.80 and £1333.62.

HEIFERS: 14 HEAD

As ever, demand from the butchers and wholesalers at ringside saw handyweight quality types a good selling trade, while heavyweight commercials would be 8p dearer on the week. The section and sale were topped at 226p for a Limousin from Steve Webster, other Limousin's sold to 217p from Richard Grindal with Messrs Fountaine at 212p. Heavyweights sold to £1419.28 from High House Farm, with Messrs Caswell, Simmentials to £1398.25.

OTM's and COWS: 7 HEAD

Totally inadequate entry met a flying trade for the cattle forward, with 6 men wanting to buy cattle. Top Price of 150p was paid for an overage Shorthorn Steer, Cows sold to 127p from Messrs Tivey for a continental cross.

Trade can go up and can go down. Calls before the sale saw buyers cancel and report absolutely radio silence on the sales front. That said a trade of 199p/kg SQQ across 2389 Hoggs a testimony to the power of the buyers in attendance despite a few no shows this week. Trade though undoubtedly a lot harder with mid weight Hoggs and poor grading Hoggs very hard to shift. Best trade today though for top end export Hoggs with all parties having jobs for them. Top today for a very shapely if light Charolais x from J Wallis at 260p/kg for 30kg ahead of 39kg Beltex at 256p/kg from D Mitchell and 254p/kg for 35kg from Richard Fountaine. N Walker, Burford sold 39kg to 249p/kg with Fountaines and N Walker also 247 and 244p/kg. Heavier Hoggs topping at 208p/kg at 52kg from Rocky Poulson with 46.5kg at 208p/kg from NF Hodges & Son with Slapton Manor 46kg to 207p/kg. In the lump best lambs seeing a top of £100 for 39kg from Dabba Mitchell with Laurence Kerby £99.20 for 44kg and N Walker 39kg to £97. Overall heavies hard hit today with very little home trade a result of the Nation paying for its Christmas celebrations. £114 a top for 72kg from Slapton Manor with others £113 at 62kg and £110 for Rocky Poulson.


