A very difficult trade for Export weights throughout as last weeks national increase in trade seemingly tested and then broke the elasticity of demand for UK lamb. Best meat Lambs a remaining strong trade but shelly Export types much harder to fit throughout. AN SQQ of 256p/kg still strong but a steady on the week. Best end lambs the real trade for the day seeing top trade Beltex to 346p/kg at 39kg for Hillside Farm. L Threadgold & Son sold equal quality to 327p/kg at 39.5kg and 40kg Beltex to 308p/kg from M Woodward. RF & J Nichols 45kg to 304p/kg. Heavies again the best trade throughout topping at 308p/kg for 50kg from Hillside Farm with R Richins 46kg Beltex to 303p/kg and J & R Lowe 54kg at 296p/kg with Messrs Nichols 50.5kg 295p/kg. Meat the key throughout and often to many very lean. In the lump export weights topping out at £137 for 45kg for Messrs Nichols and £135 for 39kg from Hillside. 45kg proper finished meat from E A Hull £134.50 and £130 for 44.5kg. Overall a top of £169 for 71.5kg from C Glover with 58kg from Hillside to £164 and Messrs Lowe £160 to £164. Meat must be present. Sadly a high value product such as lamb currently hard to market at the other end.
