Top for the day H McCurdie with Blue Texels at 41kg making a massive 590p/kg with N Deeley 39kg at 534p/kg and the first of J & H Tustian 43kg to 493p/kg. Hoggs with shape all 480p/kg plus and with plenty of suitors. Meat Export weights trading 420p/kg plus throughout. Leaner first cross 410 – 420 and only the very poor under 400p/kg. Heavies a real trade and 529p/kg at 38kg for Folly Fields Farm at 48kg with H McCurdie 48kg at 521p/kg and Folly Fields 496-497p/kg for 48kg Heavies all but the lean breaking 400p/kg and a real trade for all. Todays all in Avg striking towards £200 at £197 all in!!! Export Hoggs to a top of £242 for 41kg from H McCurdie ahead of N Deeley with 39kg at £220 and Henry Tustian 43kg to £212and the Windsor Egg man 45.5kg to £210. 
