Another yarding of just under 1900 as numbers steady a little as meat seemingly dries up. A trade of two halves. Meat very much in demand with buyers two deep. Lean hoggs now very hard to sell and some outlets killing these as Ewes. Meat is key. An Sqq of 299p/kg though a real mark of buyer power. Top today fed Hoggs from Leam Farm Partners to see 39kg to 396p/kg with M woodward 39.5kg to 390p/kg and Messrs Burbidge 357p/kg. Fyfe & Nephew 45kg to 356p/kg. Export weights with meat all trading 300p/kg plus whilst lean Hoggs 270-290p/kg and very lean 250p/kg. Heavies to 335p/kg for 46.5kg from W Grindal and R Woodward 334p/kg and Messrs W & I Grindal 50kg 330p/kg. Export weights in the lump to £156 for 44kg and Leam Partners 39.5kg to £154.50 and Messrs Woodward 39.5kg to £154. Overall a top of £182 for M Woodward with Messrs Fyfe £175 and Doody Livestock £173 with A Keeling £172. A trade that remain a flyer. Meat though needed lean Hoggs almost unwanted.


