Hoggs: Numbers desperately short throughout but meat in general a flying trade with only the leaner first cross Hoggs falling back. An Sqq of 291p/kg a real trade throughout with best end fed Hoggs absolutely flying today. Plenty of quality past 320p/kg with a top of 40.5kg from Rob and Trudy Burman at 351p/kg for Beltex x with 44kg from Hillside at 345p/kg and RF & J Nichols Texels at 44kg to 341p/kg. MJ Woodward Beltex 42.5kg at 339p/kg. Export Lambs generally 290p/kg plus with export weight first cross 280p/kg. Heavies the real order of the day and the meat needed for the current trade often found in the weighted Hoggs. Top today Charolais Hoggs at 48kg from Messrs Poulson & Co at 338p/kg whilst 52kg from K Crabtree 331p/kg with others 52kg at 327p/kg. Woody 47kg at 323p/kg. Meat a real trade and weight no discount today. An all in Avg of £126 for Hoggs today including a fair few small clear up runs. Export Hoggs topping the Gross at £152 for 44kg from Hillside Farm with 44kg from RF & J Nichols 44kg to £150 and K Crabtree 45kg to £149 also selling 44.5kg at £146. Plenty of Export Hoggs trading £130 plus throughout. Weight always paying and some massive top Gross figures today seeing a top of £172 and £170 for K Crabtree at 52kg with super Beltex. Kieth also taking £168 with overnight Hoggs from Messrs Caswell to £168 at 56kg. Messrs Caswell x2 Crabtree, Poulson, Edwards, Goode & Miss Zoe Collett all breaking £160.

Meat the key and clean crutches essential. Numbers dangerously low today and many more needed. Trade a flyer for meat and merely a response to a shortage of National Supply. Sales hard on numbers throughout Europe and Britain as is customery for January but Supply hold a nice equilibrium.

White Face of Charolais with weight £150 plus Suffolks to £135 for B T Caswell and £130 for Messrs Georgetti up from Kent. Suffolk with weight generally £120 plus but not much quality today. Mules to £104 for E Bullman and £100 for Messrs Caswell. Mules generally £85 to £90 if weighted.
