PRIME CATTLE: 31 Head

A reduced entry, due to six day standstill after the Store Sale, was on offer to a good company of buyers with a regular buyer making a welcome reappearance. The talk prior to the sale was doom and gloom with abattoirs having waiting lists, deadweight prices dropped, and cows a disaster. However trade was good throughout with everything wanted and the best cattle dearer by 4-5 pence on the week.

BULLS: A single Simmental bull this week grossed £1177.14, and as ever more are required.

STEERS: 9 Head

An entry dominated by weight, saw demand stronger throughout with weight not an issue as previous weeks. Frank Hodgkin topped the section with a heavyweight Limousin at 215p, others sold to 206p for grass- Angus's from Ivan Tivey. Heavyweights sold to £1363.05 from Messrs Harrison, Townthorns.

HEIFERS: 21 Head

The majority of the entry, saw demand from all corners of the ring and many more could have easily have been sold to vendors advantage. The section and sale was topped at 225p for a tremendous homebred Limousin from Messrs Trivett, who sold others to 220p. Blonde's sold to 211p from Messrs Clayton, Frank Hodgkin had 208p for Limousin Cross. Heavyweights sold to £1278.20 from Atherstone and £1254 from Byfield.

OTM's and Cows:15 Head

Extra buyer presence in the section saw all types dearer on the week, Overage sold to a top of 134p for an aged Devon Steer from Messrs McCurdie which grossed £1106.84. Cows though short in numbers were a better quality show and a tremendous run of sucklers from John Wrench and Family topped at 136p for a Limousin Cross , Red Limousin's from J.R. Morris also sold to 136p. Heavyweights sold to £1195.44 from Hillside Farm, but possibly the trade of the day was the Dexter which grossed £342.93.

PRIME LAMBS: 2563 Forward SQQ 177p/kg

Once again a bumper number of lambs with 2600 lambs in the aisles and once again very few of them booked in. Buyers cannot be expected to merely stand and deliver on buying whole lorry loads of lambs over those they have budgeted for. Testament to the loyalty of our buyers though, that they bought more than needed to service the vendors. An Sgg of 177p/kg a stand on trade despite a drop in the average quality of lambs on parade. Best lambs heavily competed for but a number of buyers not showing today due to a lack of demand for sheep meat. In the Euro a top today of 210p/kg for 40.5kg from Rob and Peter Calcott, Sheepy Magna with properly fed Beltex and neighbours I & T Greenfield showed lambs held in overnight to 39.5kg at 200p/ kg. Garfield Stephens, Oakham saw 43kg at 200p/kg and P Jarrom, Leicester, Martin Baylis, Buckingham and W & J Griffin, Oakham all hitting 200p/kg at 41kg. In the heavies a top of 46kg at 183p/kg for BF Humphrey & Sons and W & J Griffin 46kg at 180p/kg. Heavies from Kevin Welsby showed proper lambs at 49.5kg to 179p/kg whilst 46kg from Messrs Griffin, seeing feeding rewarded at 180p/kg. In the lump Eurp weights topping out at £86 for 43kg from G Stephens whilst B C Burton 44kg to £86 and Coventry vendor N Barratt & Partners 44kg to £85. Heavies still wanted but truthfully reaching over supply nationally. Top £99 for 60kg from MFH Farming with A Tarry Smith equal money at 63kg and R Bywater & Son £95 at 61kg for the last lamb sold on the day.

Trade cautious and our consistent bucking of the national trend only a tribute to out buyers loyalty.

Friday 12th October Store Cattle Fair: 353 Forward

The First of the Autumn sales last Friday saw a ring full of buyers all of which provided a dead trade with the large number of accounts with little enthusiasm for mid range or cold store cattle. A bewilderingly slow trade throughout with the strength of buyers in attendance but seemingly buyers unsure as to the future of Beef returns but sure of the increased daily costs of keeping Stores. Trade easily £150 back on the year albeith the quality of stock on show perhaps attributing for £50 worth of this. Young cattle a better than predicted trade with 10 month Steers from D & GM Wright setting us off at £745 for Simmentals and yearling Abgus from L C Threadgold to £810.Mid-range Cattle 14 to 17 months hardest to place and generally £800 to £900 albeit strong forward sorts saw £1080 and £1100 for 17 month Simmentals from R E Tustian, Chacombe and Angus Heifers of a similar age from M Lee to £1085. Weighted and farmed Steers the order of the day selling to £1220 for two pens full from PD & C Davenport at 20 to 23 months of age with others £1195. Top Heifer from J D Stephens at £1105 for 18 month. An incredibly difficult days trading despite the long distance travelling buying support. The summers drought has its effect and this cannot be avoided. Vendors should ask if they are selling cattle due to shortage of food, are the cattle they selling ready for a fixed feeding ration? If not it is likely the next man has no Store ration either.
