## SPRING LAMBS 2195 FORWARD SQQ 328P/KG AVG £141.32



More in all Sections with 2200 Lambs forwards returning an SQQ of 328p/kg! A yarding of meat in general, with some super runs of quality forwards, but today also saw 200 or so very, very lean lambs that would be £20 dearer on a Thursday Store Sale. Meat, though, was a real trade, and buyers were fit from start to finish.

Top today was 412p/kg for 39kg from Ian Wain with Beltex, and 406p/kg for Messrs Roots. W Bartlett, up from Winslow, also broke 403p/kg, with D W Gurney, using the M40, taking 393p/kg for 43kg. Meat and shape were on fire today, with export orders popping, and meat lambs with finish trading regularly over 340p/kg. First-cross meat lambs were trading at 330–310p/kg, and the very lean lambs were at 280–300p/kg.

Heavies again were not the flyer we've seen all season but still fast throughout. Topping at 371p/kg for 48kg from C R Hill, Leicester, and 46kg from G R Fountaine & Son at 368p/kg. V Roots and Taylor & Son hit 360p/kg at 46kg. Meat was regularly trading over 330p/kg. Weight in general was at 310p/kg, with heavy Suffolks and Mule-bred lambs at 300p/kg. Super heavies were out of vogue and a much harder sell.

An all-in average of £142 was recorded throughout—a serious average, with a fair few clearing the hedges today. A competition for the lightest fat lambs sold took place, with small but beautiful Orphans (24–27kg). Export lambs topped out at £172 for 45kg from DD Pugh, Leicester, with DW Gurney & Son achieving £169 for 43kg, and G Bennett & Partners, from Gloucester, seeing 45kg at £167. Meat was well chased throughout.

The top price today was £190 for the Gloucester wonderer, G Bennett & Partners, at 60kg, with HL Goode & Son achieving £187 for 69kg, and W Bartlett reaching £186 for 58kg. I Wain and P Edwards both broke £180.

Today, 600 lambs were clipped, all selling at a premium. The clipping service will be available Sunday night and Monday, from now on.

## CULL EWES: 1027 FORWARD

Many more about today and a real show of weight for the first time in months, with just shy of 1100 ewes averaging £143! The trade was simply a flyer, with all major ewe abattoirs represented. Travelled ewes from Cornwall and Norfolk were forward today—genuine farmed ewes, with no buy-back schemes involved.

The trade was a real Christmas present, selling to £242 for Charolais from J & R Lowe, with Texels from AA Peck across from Norfolk at £240 and £227. Passmore & Nunnerly, a little less travelled but still strong, saw £225, with Messrs Peck also at £222. Ricky Brendon, up from Cornwall, saw £220. Messrs Peck, Norwich, had 23 further ewes over £200, with VJ Roots' Beltex at £211 and Jamie Best's Dorset at £207. Messrs Wain and Roots also broke £200.

White faces with weight today were trading between £160 and £200 throughout. Suffolks reached £194 for T J Griffith and Messrs Peck, and £191 for J Lowe. Suffolks were generally £170 plus. Mules reached £184 for JM Grace and £182 for Mules with weight, almost all of which were over £140.

Lean ewes remain hard to sell. Compared to last Thursday's Grazing Ewe Sale, they should be shown there when AHDB tax is not due.
