A massively decreased number as Trade steadies numbers coming forward as does the deluge of rain witnessed over the weekend. The 900 forward though very well chased with Butchers to the Fore to see an SQQ of 250.50p/kg a marvellous return compared to Deadweight £4-60 to £5 if you can get them in. IN real terms a real trade throughout but Export Lambs still the sticking point with them trading 2.35 to 2.50 for run of the mill bred lambs. Best meat well in advance. Top today Beltex Hopper lambs at 38.5kg to 304p/kg from Hillside with Messrs Fountaine 34kg to 303p/kg. 41kg from Hillside 298p/kg and 40kg at 290p/kg. Lightweight meat also selling well for the Leicestershire Supporters Club an ever growing population, when G Mann sold Southdown City Lambs to 283p/kg. Meat and finish well chased. Heavies back on form this week selling to 267p/kg for 51kg from JJV Hollands and 46kg to 265p/kg from W Bartlett. SLAM Farming 49kg at 265p/kg and D G Coombes 51kg to 258p/kg.

An all in avg of £109.50 a real testament the trade here today!! Export lambs topping at £124 for 43kg for Hillside and £122 for 41kg. EJ Taylor 43kg to £120. Ovearll super meat and shape topping the day. £152 for 63kg from RF & J Nichols also selling 58kg to £149 and 59kg the same. JJV Hollands 61kg to £149. Messrs Westland, Goode and Nichols all beating the £140 mark. Trade just as sticky on the Sales side but numbers steadying nationally starting to help.

Fed Lambs still making a premium and the figures adding up.

From the 1st January all Sunday night lairage fat sheep will be subject to compulsory clipping either by the vendor or by the Sunday night clipping team.
