CATTLE : 41 Forward

Extra buyers at ringside, cattle numbers continue to disappoint, but trade every bit as dear as previous weeks with butcher heifers in particular benefitting from extra butcher presence at ringside.

BULLS: The entry contained all types from pure bred beef types to pure bred Holstein types, the section was topped by Mr. Page with a South Devon at 216p, others from Messrs Lea sold to 190p as ever more are needed to supply demand.

STEERS: Another nice entry for quality, but lacked numbers met a good commercial selling trade with demand strong from all corners of the ring. A well- muscled heavyweight from Richard Fountaine topped the section at 215p others sold to 204p for grass-fed Simmental's from Messrs Timbs who's trailer-load averaged 203p. Top price per head was £1436.20 from GR Fountaine.

HEIFERS: Entry included several runs of quality yarded and grass-fed heifers which met excellent competition from ringside. The section and sale was topped by a super black limousin from Richard Fountaine at 235p, others sold to 215p from Steve Powell with a yarded Simmental. Grass Angus's sold 214p from Messrs Tivey, who's trailer-load averaged 201p. Heavyweights sold to £1382 again from GR Fountaine.

COWS: Short entry saw trade strong with all types wanted, Top price was £1067.22 per head and 126p per kilo for a white cow from Messrs Lea, Lutterworth. Pure Herefords sold to £974.68 from Messrs Mann. Farmers, buyer strength at ringside could easily handle 70 plus cattle on a weekly basis, and remember no T.B. Test needed for this ring and Maximum Commission is £25 a head.

SHEEP:2514 PRIME LAMBS: 1742 Forward SQQ 182p/kg

Hard work all around. Firstly thank you for everyone's cooperation as we sold through the ring. We did though manage to post an SQQ of 182p/kg which seems to represent a trade above alternatives, but no hiding the fact that buyers today simply not requiring lambs, nothing to do with the value, they just seem unable to market lamb meat in the current weather conditions throughout Europe. Numbers today of 1750 higher than booked in with those struggling at the local abattoir to make any sensible returns piling lambs in to market today. Trade slipping all around and a testament to our buyers that we came out on top for the days trading. In the Euro spec lambs a top today of 211ppk from C Gregory, Fenny Compton at 43kg with W J Pearson & Son 41kg 210p/kg at 41kg with Boulton Bros equal at 43kg. in the heavies a top of 198p/kg for 46kg from J Meusal, Coventry and 197p/kg from George Scrivens, Mitcheldean Gloucester. L G Russell, Stratford Upon Avon 50kg to 188p/kg. In the lump Euro lambs topped out at £90.50 for 43kg from Messrs Gregory with Boulton Bros £90 at equal weight. Messrs Meusal 45kg to £86. Overall heavies hard to shift today with little interest around and about but selling to £102 from Midland Environmental at 60kg with Harrison Bros, £99 for 55kg and Angela Tarry-Smith £96 at 53.5kg. Lambs today a real struggle and vendors perhaps needing to prepare for a period of unease in the trade.
