Trade slipping all around, with this center top SQQ for the day, with some good runs of quality lambs, but an SQQ of 174ppk representative of the trade nationwide. In the Euros today a top ppk of 222ppk to Rosie Leach with Beltex at 45kg ahead of R Richins with Beltex at 43kg to 208ppk. Pete Batchelor showed the usual stamp to see Beltex to 200ppk at 37k with others from the same home to 195ppk for 43kg and 42kg pens respectively. In the heavies R Richin showed Beltex to 199ppk at 47kg, and 196ppk at 51kg, before Pete Batchelor struck again to sell 46.5kg Beltex to 183ppk. Robert Leach sold 50kg Beltex to 178ppk, with BC Burton to 176ppk on 46kg Texels. In the lump the euro lambs topped by Rosie Leach, with her 45kg Beltex to £100, whilst R Richin sold 43kg Beltex to £89.50. 43kg Beltex from Pete Batchelor to £84, with others from the same stable to £82 at 42kg, with BC Burton close behind to see 44kg Texels to £81.50. Top gross however seeing weight pay with 62 kg Suffolk x to £100 from A Tarry-Smith, with R Richins selling 51 kg Beltex to £100 also. Suffolk x again from A Tarry-Smith saw 58kg to £98.50, with Ted Taylor selling 66.5kg Charollais x to £98, and Robert Goode's lambs, the same way bred reaching £93.50 at 57kg.

A much reduced entry for our first October fair, due to the evils of TB and breakdowns in transport. That said the cattle which did appear, held a good trade. Feeding bulls to start saw Sussex x from Olly Pritchett to £500 at 14 months, before Ian Birden sold Limousin x heifers to £805 at 8 month. D& GM Wright saw strong 11 month old Simmental x steers to £900, with Simmental x heifers to £800 at a similar age. Tom Greenfield showed bucket reared Angus x steers to £900 at 16 months, before Frankie Badger sold Angus x Steers at 14 months to £865. A jump in the ages saw RE Tustian sell a run of strong Simmental x steers to £1210 at 16 months with the heifers topping at £1020 at a similar age, and a load average of £986 for 24 cattle. EC Parker & Son sold Charolais x steers to £1100 at 14 months, before TR Dickson Sussex took £1090 for Angus x steers at 17 months. TH Morris & son sold pure Simmental heifers to £1080 at 16 months with J Peebles selling Limousin x steers to £1150 at a similar age. RJ&P Milner sold South Devons to £1135 for steers at 19 months, with others to £1120, before HH Wadland & Sons also sold South Devon steers to £1155, also at 19months. Richard Wrights strong run saw Angus x steers to £1200 at 23 months with a run of 25 averaging £1040. Up the ages again saw GM & LD Robson sell Beef Shorthorn steers to top the sale at £1300 at 24 months, with others from the same home to £1190, before Haycock & Partners sold Hereford x Steers to £1100 at 22 months and heifers to £940 at a similar age.
