AT Edwards, R Heckford, R Burman all breaking the 300p/kg mark. Weight remains the vogue as Export trades Iull. Meat and weight therefore remain the best target. Heavies seeing a top of 305p/kg at 46.5kg for PJ East with J W Lowe 49.5kg to 295p/kg and N Deeley 46.5kg 290p/kg. JA Owen 48.5kg 287p/kg.

In the lump Export weights topping out at £129 for 44kg from LA & VS Evans, Thame. F Hodgkin 44kg to £126 with V Phipps, Banbury to £126 at 45kg and 44.5kg to £126 also.
