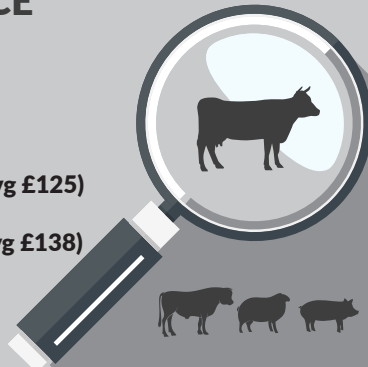

Cattle; A nice yarding of Cattle with meat on display but very little to tantalise the graders. Trade must be reported as a little steadier as is the consensus nationally with Wholesalers reporting a harder selling environment.

Steers; Some shape and lean meat at the top end from C W Thomas taking the Butchers Eyes at 291 & 281p/kg x2. heavy weight from D W Gurney & Son saw 267p/kg. R grades up to 250p/kg mark with plenty of weight and most 245p/kg plus. O+ Cattle all well over 234p/kg. Top gross £2088 for D Gurney with Hull Farms £1924 and Gurney £1915 Sabin and Thomas also over £1900.

Heifers; Butchers spec with U Grade plumbs from F A Osbourne selling 2.93p/kg and 290p/kg from P Jarrom. R Grades into the 270p/kg mark with almost all over 250p/kg and O grades regularly touching 2.50p/kg. Top gross £1730 from A Sabin with Messrs Hull £1720 and N Foster £1695.

Buls; weight all about and seeing huge weight to 243p/kg from C H Evans & Son with Charolais from Hull Farms 241p/kg. Super Heavies to 232p/kg. Top gross a massive £2274 and £2031 from C H Evans & Son with Simmental. £1936 for Angus from Hull Farms.

A super yard of meat today and a jump in quality. Sqg of 289p/kg a marvellous return with power of buyers for the 1500 on show from Start to finish. Light under finished Hoggs much harder to place than we have seen but meat a fast trade throughout. Ives Livestock showing all the quality needed and some super shape finish and patience in their run of 120 Beltex Hoggs topping at 368p/kg for 38kg pens with 44.5kg to 340p/kg and 43kg 326p/kg. Messrs Edmunds up from Caerphilly sold proper quality at 45.5kg to 316p/kg. Heavies simply amazing and fast throughout. Dominated again by team Ives Livestock selling 47.5kg to 326p/kg and 48kg to 319p/kg. Amorise Farms 50kg to 302p/kg. Export grossing a top of £151.50 for 44.5kg from Ives Livestock with Messrs Edmunds £145 at 45kg and L Threadgold & son 45 kg to £141.50. Hundreds and hundreds of sheep today over £150 and Vendors rewarded for the super show of meat. Top gross though dominated with the top 7 pens sold by PR Baker down from Lincolnshire whom sold 206 Hoggs to avg a whopping £169!!!!!!! Top today £178 and £176 for 80kg and 71kg from this super run of sheep with 5 pens then all at £175. Greenfield of Twycroas showed super quality with 61kg £170. Trade today a new level but meat much more present than we have seen for a number of weeks and hasn't it paid dividends.

Past 1100 Lambs today and in truth a poor show of quality to that expected this time of year and perhaps a sign of the lack of grass. an Ssq of 322p/kg a continued favourable trade but restricted by a number of lambs short on finish. Buyers throughout the market today and around every corner but Lambs still holding less than half the audience of the Hogg with the switchover yet to come it seems. Top end Lambs very dear selling to 380p/kg from BJ & IS wain with L G Russell 379p/kg and Page Bros 375p/kg. Pritchard Farms penned one of the few Export spec pens to see 38.5kg at 364p/kg. Heavier lambs a bit more bite today seeing 46kg 322p/kg from Heckford MBE and 47kg from Messrs Baker to 320p/kg. Top gross £153 for 49kg shape from Pritchard Farms and 53kg from Ted Taylor. P & F Baker 47kg to £150.50. Best Export weight to £150 for 41kg from P Cobley with 38kg from Pritchard Farms £140. Meat is the key for this commodity and Lambs must be fit to find preference over the Hogs for exporters.
