PRIME CATTLE: 18 HEAD

A typical pre-holiday market with a small entry forward, some firms and butchers wanting to top up stocks, several buyers not forward due to slow demand and sales. Several regular vendors busy with Christmas poultry and late shopping. Those farmers who sold would be delighted with the trade received from the ringside in particular those selling heifers.

STEERS:5 HEAD

An entry dominated by weight, with saw demand strong throughout with all weights in demand and more could have been sold to advantage. The section was topped at 227p for a Limousin from Messrs Ferguson Ltd who travelled up from Kent with a load of well finished cattle. Others sold to 226p from Frank Page, heavyweights sold to £1478.04 from Lodge Farm House.

HEIFERS:13 HEAD

Some tremendous quality runs of continental heifers with meat in abundance, and demand was strong at ringside from the butchers present. A storming Belgium Blue topped the section and sale at 240p from Frank Page who sold others to 233p. Messrs Ferguson sold others to 227p for a Limousin. Top price per head was £1320 from Page Bros, who sold others to £1290.82.

PRIME LAMBS: 1633 Forward SQQ 199p/kg

A woefully short entry in comparison to the number of lambs expected today and buyers furious at the lack of supply on the one Monday when a lifted demand seemed a certainty. Those that did show though selling to a strong trade that got dearer throughout the sale to level at an SQQ of 199p/kg. Best fed and meat lambs in high demand with a returning exporter after the best sorts. In the Euro section a top ppk of 248p/kg for a pen full of Beltex at 36.5kg from D Mitchell. P A Barnes & Son, Tamworth sold meated Texels to 237p/kg at 40.5kg and SJ Basher 34kg to 235p/kg. A lorry load of sheared lambs from Garth Weston, Thame sold to 232p/kg at 38kg whilst Chris Osborne, Leighton Buzzard saw 223p/kg for 40kg. In the heavies meat chased ferociously topping at 200p/kg at 46kg from Humphrey Livestock equal with B C Burton whilst smart meat 50kg 195p/kg. In the lump Euro lambs really clocking up today to top out at £97 for 44kg from B C Burton whilst Messrs Barnes 40.5kg to £96 with £95.50 for 20 from B C Burton for 44kg. Overall a top of £119 for 75kg Rams from R & B Smith with J T Jeyes & Son the last man sold taking £113 at 63kg and BMF Smith £112.50 for a pen of 11 at 65kg. Today 143 lambs turning over three figures. Trade to be monitored and we go again on Friday with sheep once again. Please do book in turning up.

A catalogue entry of 100 cattle saw several un-entered lots forward, the value of the auction system was apparent when the sale commenced with all types of cattle forward from the 6mth Jersey bulls, Jersey-Angus Bulls, through the ages to 2year old Angus and Hereford Steers and Heifers, all meeting good competition from the local and distant farmers at ringside. The sale commenced with a Simmental Cow with twin calves from Steve Eales which made £1480. H.M.P. Prison, Hewell Grange run of reared Jersey and JerseyxAngus Bulls topped at £410. Reared calves from Messrs Smith sold between £310-385 for dairy bred steers and heifers. Stronger cattle saw yearlings to £705 from Manor Farm Partnership for a Blue Steer, with the majority £570-680. Strong cattle were in demand selling to £1020 for a Hereford Steer from Mick Taylor, who sold other Herefords to £935, Mick dominated the strong cattle selling a pen of 6 AAx heifers at £850 and a brother for £860.


