A tremendous day in the cattle section, increased numbers on offer to a strong buyer presence at ringside with another noted midland wholesaler present, (Mr. M come and look). Trade was electric with bids coming from all corners of the ring for everything from the pure bred well finished continentals to weathered freisian steers.

Bulls: 2 Head

An entry lacking flesh sold to 179 p for a dairy bred 17 month old from Michael Sharlot. 22 month old Holstein lacking flesh sold to 136p. Every week buyers are requesting bulls, lets have them.

Steers: 24 Head.

An entry dominated by weight, saw demand strong throughout with commercial types on fire. Lacking the showstoppers of previous weeks, Parry Walters topped at 212 with a heavy-weight Limousin, others from Frank Hodgkin to 209p. Top price per head was £1309.50 from Roger and Tom Elliott.

Quality entry for meat, buyers bidding in all corners of the ring, trade on fire. The Trivett Family bought another trailerload of superb quality cattle and topped the sale at 233p and 230p. Roger and Tom Elliott not to be outdone sold heavyweights to 225p and Frank sold others to 221p. The trade of the day was for the commercial well fed beef which looked a marvellous trade at 194-207p. Top price per head was £1414.54 from Frank Hodgkin.

#### OTM's: 20 Head:

Increased numbers saw trade sharper throughout with everything wanted, several cattle around the 30-33 month met a wonderful trade and makes a mockery of the 30 month rule. Ces Thomas and Family sold a Blue heifer to 210p, with Gordon Robson having 160 for a heavyweight Shorthorn. Red Polls full of flesh topped at 141p from Mark Martin.

Cows were an improved trade with more buyers looking for them, Worked Charolais cows from Mr. Steels sold to 130p with 179 month Continental cow from John Arther realising 127p. Dairy cows from Messrs Dalby, Cesterover sold to 115p and averaged 111p.

#### PRIME LAMBS: 1155 Forward SQQ 175p/kg

A steep decrease in number this week with barely over 1100 lambs on parade returning and SQQ of 175p/kg. Trade lethargic at best albeit the National average of the day under 170p/kg showing competition to be key. Two weekly stalwarts not even in attendance as they report slow counter sales and very slow continental orders. Two brand new accounts in the isles today a consequence of the rejuvenated cattle section. As ever meat wanted but lean lambs and those weighing under 41kgs hard to shift as they produce a carcass outside of the required spec. In the Euro section top of 215p/kg and 214p/kg for Shannon and Dave Mitchell with butchers Beltex lambs. Fed meated lambs from R Richins, Oxford saw 200p/kg and 202p/kg for 40.5kgs and 41.5kgs. In the heavies a top of 181p/kg for 46.5kgs B C Burton and 180p/kg from the same home for 46kgs. In the lump 39kg Beltex to £84 from S Mitchell and 45kgs to £83 from B C Burton. Heavies the most difficult trade of the season as supply outsrips demand. A top though of £101 for 59kgs from DTP & PA Walters close behind from BF Humphries 59kgs to £99. Trade very difficult throughout but all a response of an inability to sell at the other end. As the end of the month nears returning holiday makers will surely receive their salaries stimulating meat trade. PLEASE BOOK SHEEP IN DO NOT JUST TURN UP.
