

Aged Cows and Calves from Messrs Herbert saw a top of £1670 for a Simmental Cow 2012 with 4 month Steer calf at foot with others £1620. Younger units showing a harder winter from Ibbetson & Crawley saw £1730 for 2018 Simmentals with 3 month Simmental Bull Calves at foot with 2014 units similar at £1720 and £1700. A change of units saw South Devons 2018 and 2 month old Calves from RJ & P Milner to £1800 and £1750. A monstrous Lim x Cow with 2015 and 6 week old Lim Calf at foot making a marvellous £2200, for S Ronch.

Store Cattle next and the overall conclusion being that best end bred Cattle and aged Cattle very dear and seeing serious demand. Second quality and mid aged Cattle a harder sell with seasonal grazers yet to strike.

Bulls first in seeing a good enquiry for mainly young sorts seeing a top £720 for Lim x from T H Morris & Sons. Bucket Bulls from C G Betteridge very well done saw 6 month olds to £550 and £500 with British Friesian to £405 for a pen full of 6. Into the young Stores and real enquiry for Hem Co, Henley in Arden seeing £1000 for Lim x Steers at 10 months with Blondes £955 and other Lim x £990. Heifers from the same saw 9 month Blondes to £940 and Lim x to £860. The run of cattle a credit to the Dairy Farmers Stockmanship. Next in Amy Wright with Angus at 10 months to see Steers £910 and Heifers £750. Strength from W R Eales with Simmentals to £920 for yearling Steers with others £840. RP Waterfall Ltd back down the M1 for another week from Stanford on Soar seeing his run of very well done dairy Calves top at £705 for Blues 11 months with others £670 for large pens full. The annual tranche from Tom Lowick today saw his genuine run of 12 – 15 month Limousin x take £1100, £1090, £1050 and £1020 with Sisters to £1000. Angus yearlings to £905 for a pair of Steers with others £900 and heifers £800 from JS & N Morley. Again real strength from S & J Farming with Charolais Heifers topping at £1145 for a pair at 13 months with large pens at £1030. Steers only 9 months old took £1005. Ibbetson & Crawley giving buyers of their Cows real confidence when selling Simmental Steers at 15 months £1220 with yearlings to £1090 for pairs and large pens £1020. Sisters to £910 and £855. JA & S Wrench with a loyal following with returning buyers keen for return success from their Limousin bred Cattle. First in a 11 month old Lim x Steer saw £1200 with 10 month old at £1055, £1050, £1015 and £1005. 9 month olds to £1000 and 7 month old £900. More dairy men forward to see Angus at £1020 for yearlings from FE & CJ Barnett selling Blues to £900 and Angus to £840 for 11-12 month Steers. Blue Sisters to £900. P Amor next man in with a super Blue Steer showing real shape at no age with his 11 month old taking £1200. Simmental Steers 11 months to £1010 and Bucket Blues £800 and £840 10 months of age. Young heifers 9 months to £760 for bucket done sorts. P & F Baker Leicester showed frame to £950 for Simmental Steers 15 months and yearlings £925 others £855 and Heifers £875. C H Evans showing a good advert for their breeding Bulls when selling Simmental Heifers 19 – 22 months at £1460 for a trio with a large pen of 17 to 20 month at £1380 with others £1300.

Blues much younger saw 14 months at £1200 and £1120 and Simmental 17 months £1245. Simmental Steers 15 months from Messrs Herbert saw £1100. J O Smith, Lapworth showed Limousin Heifers only 16 months to £1325 with AF Thompson, Coventry £1130 for Simmentals 16 months of age. Jane Gilbert next bringing all the shape to see a Steer 16 months at £1415 then £1350 21 month and £1260 15 months. Simmental x Heifers from Palmers of Shipston on Stour saw £915 16-18 months. Younger Cattle from Tom Greefield this week saw a top of £900 for Hereford Buckets Steers at 14 months and Angus £840 16 months. Messrs Liggins run of outside framed Blondes saw a first trip to this venue fruitful at £1120 for Blondes 23 month Steers and Heifers £1130 and £910 for a large pen full. Strength short nationally and Philip and Jake Davenport paced the aisles in anticipation to see a run of strength at 19 months top at £1500 for Blonde Steers with others younger 15 -17 months £1270, £12415, £1230 and £1205. Sisters £1270 and £1180. Amy Wright showed Charolais Heifers to 19 months at £1270. JA & S Wrench then seeing Lim x Steers 16 months £1300 and 19 months £1210 and £1200. Heart of England back again to top at £1250 at 15 months of age and others £1200 for Lim x Steers with sisters £1110 and Blues £1280. Milners showed aged frame at 19 months to see Simmentals £1100 and £1050. With Morley showing Angus 17 months to £1100. JO Smith Ltd then selling his older batch at £1530 for a trio of Lim x Steers 22 months and others pens full at £1220 and sisters £1200 and £1190.

Just about the 2000 Hogg mark today for a Bank Holiday Sale. In truth a lack of quality with a large number of marginally bred Hoggs on show. A change in buyer faces with one out and one in but an SQQ of 288p/kg a trade equal to last week on paper but today a lot of midweight Hoggs 44 to 45kg bringing the avg back. Export weights 43kg and under definitely dearer on the week with almost all trading over 290p/kg. Export and shape very dear today seeing a top of 358p/kg at 45kg from K Crabtree with Beltex whilst DW Gurney & Son 36.5kg at 355p/kg with 33kg to 342p/kg and 40kg 336p/kg. T Addison 42kg to 321p/kg and E A Hull 40kg at 318p/kg. Heavies with shape in vogue and seeing K Crabtree top man again at 51kg to 311p/kg and others 307p/kg and 303p/kg. Gurney 46.5kg to 301p/kg. Heavy run of the Mills remain a hard trade and over subscribed but perhaps a little more spark today with an all in avg of £124 despite 150 very small Hill Hoggs included in the avg. Export weights totting up to £161 for K Crabtree's smart Beltex whilst 44kg Blue Texel bred from I Threadgold saw 44kg at £137 and T Addison up from MK saw 42kg at £135 with D Gurney 40kg at £134.50. E A Hull took 44kg to £133.50. In the lump Heavies saw 51kg to £158.50 for Crabtree with E Hull 53kg to £158 and K Attfield 69kg to £158. Crabtree 56kg to £156.50 and J Hope Sheep Services 74kg to £154 with Crabtree and Glover both also breaking the £150 mark.

Again reiterate the need to draw weights to suit buyers i.e market at 43kg and under and over 53kg plus.
