

CATTLE: 100 FORWARD



On Monday 18th July 2022 Rugby Farmers Auction held their weekly sale of Primestock.

100 Cattle forwarded included -
31 Young Bulls to 292ppk or £2085
25 Prime Bullocks to 285ppk or £1984
42 Prime Heifers to 317ppk or £1740
2 OTM Cattle 244ppk or £2605

A sign of the weather and the cost of feed. A lot of cattle forward shown because of the lack of grass and the cost of feed. Although some cattle would be under fed for what would be seen on normal years, larger bullocks still grossing between the £1600/£1750 still not possibly the worst get out of a bad situation.

Young Bulls - A cracking show of bulls forward. Bulls travelled from Suffolk didn't travel for any disappointment with 12 Young Bulls averaging over £1900 for JW Baldwin topping out at £2085. Selling to 292, 289, 288(3) 287 286 285 284PPK.

CH Evans, Warwick also with a fantastic entry of bulls sold over £2000 at £2046.

Prime Bullocks - As mentioned above a much more under finished show of bullocks what we've seen in previous weeks, although the pence per kilo wouldn't be highest. The weight over the bridge and the grossing value of the bullocks for a lesser input wouldn't be too disappointing.

The Fountaine family topped the day in the bullocks at 285ppk with some lovely fed cattle.

Ed Hull topped the pounds per head with big lad at £1984.

HF Bowley, Buckinghamshire returning with their bullocks to £1872 £1837 £1778.

Prime Heifers - A shortage of best butchers quality heifers forward as 90 percent of the sale would be dairy bred and handy weight.

Pete, Emma & Charlie Jarrom topped the day with a beautiful limousin heifer that was fed to perfection at 317ppk, another heifer from the same home sold to 301ppk.

GR Fountaine topped the £'s at £1740. (296ppk)

OTM & Cull Cattle.

A massive shortage of overage cattle. However CH Evans had forward a Stock Bulls that sold to 244ppk or a huge £2605!!!

Unprecedented times on the weather front and time for Staff, Vendors, Buyers and Hauliers to work together. Starting at 3am numbers processed through the system at workable temperatures. Numbers a little shy of normal to be expected in the weather conditions. Trade flying for mid and heavy weights as Catering Markets opened the days trading short of requirements. Export weights a little resistance with 37 to 40kg seeing a smaller audience. An SQQ of 314p/kg though a super return miles ahead of any deadweight ability showing returns over 650p/kg. Weighted Lambs the real order of the day and those well finished. Weather starting to take its toll and a few rows of lean lambs on show today. Best end today in great demand seeing a top of 369p/kg for small blocks from Peebles Farm Services with 38kg 368p/kg for Beltex from IM Allen & Partners. P Jones sold 3/4Texels to 356p/kg for 45kg with all shape today selling over 335p/kg. Weighted Lambs in massive demand seeing 46kg from P Incley at 334p/kg with D J Leadbeater 49kg at 333p/kg and J Elkington 48kg at 331p/kg equal with J & S Truelove. An all in avg of £136 per lamb a measure of the trade throughout. In the lump a top for Exports at £160 for P Jones at only 45kg with B C Burton on parade at 45.5kg to £155 and JB Elkington £153 for 45kg. Overall heavies the hardest chased topping at £173 for lumps of lambs from MK & SM Gray at 54kg. Wardall & Son sold 56kg to £172.50 and RJ Batchelor doing her sales pitch as to why you should buy her Breeders at the end of the Month when selling 52.5kg to £172 equal with J & S Truelove. Alan and Jemima Collett bringing out the weight today with 56kg Suffolks at £170.50. Trade likely steadier on the week with extra lambs about next week nationally.
