CATTLE: 55

A disappointing entry for numbers was easily accommodated by the full ring of 10 buyers looking for all types, ages, weight and breed of cattle. The large percentage of the entry were working class cattle proved to be the trade of the day easily 3-5 p dearer on the week.

BULLS: The trade for these were the talk of the market with the new face at ringside making his presence felt. An entry of native breeds saw dairy types from Mike Sharlot sell to 182p for a 25 month old animal, with others from the same to 169p, this time for a 29 month old Holstein. Beef Shorthorn's sold to 182p for a 25 month old animal from Danzey Green. Top Price per head was £1219.40 with Black and Whites topping at £1130.22 from Fields Farm.

STEERS: The commercial types, everybody wanted at an increased trade, while the few cherries on offer held late rates. The section was topped at 220p for a limousin from Alan (the man) Tacy. A nice trailer-load of grass cattle from new customer Messrs Timbs, Oxon sold to 210p for a Simmental and averaged 207p for the load. Native breeds sold to 180 for dairy bred Herefords. Top price per head was £1434.40 from Peatling Parva.

HEIFERS: As ever short of requirements and with the large physical buyer presence at ringside, demand is strong for all types. Lester Smith topped the section and sale with a superb heavyweight heifer which realised 224 pence. Parry Walters changed colour this week selling black Limousin's to 217p. Heavyweight sold to £1388.80 from Preston on Stour and Blonde's to £1356.32 from Mark and Carolyn Jackson.

COWS: What have we to do to get 30+ cows in the market!!!! No real showstoppers, but a flying trade with 6 men wanting cows, Lester topped it with a Limousin Cow at 150p, but the cows in the 120-135p bracket looked the trade in the section. White Shorthorn's sold to 137p from Messrs Fenemore, Angus cows from Messrs Bryson sold to 128p, with 223 month Hereford crosses to 120p from Cosby Hill.

SPRING LAMBS: 1856 Forward SQQ 247p/kg

A large increase in lambs and a sharp fall in trade. 247p/g SQQ though one of the highest in the country. It was also worth noting that the yarding of lambs today would be the worst quality on average we have had in the market for several years. Vendors are asked not to rush lambs to sell. A sharp decrease in trade and limited enquiry today with buyers constantly being held back on the phones. That said quality lambs still a sharp enough enquiry. Shannon Mitchell top at 281p/kg for 39kg Beltex with P K Cobley 38kg to 276p/kg. Proper fed lambs from MM Clarke & Son held weight to take 273p/kg at 45kg with 44.5kg the same. In the heavies 46kg to 270p/kg from MM Clarke & Sons with 46kg 260p/kg. Richard Lowe and P & L Gibbs both 258p/kg at 46kg. In the lump £123 for 45kg from MM Clarke & Sons with 44kg at £119.50. 44 to 45kg saw £117 for Messrs Cobley and Osborn & Son. Overall weight wanted today selling to £144 for 65kg from Cecil Thomas. F J Tombs & Son £133 and £137.50 for 53 and 55kg with P & LA Gibbs 53kg to £130.50. A matter of Supply catching up with Demand nationally and abattoirs happy to stop kills rather than work for a loss.


