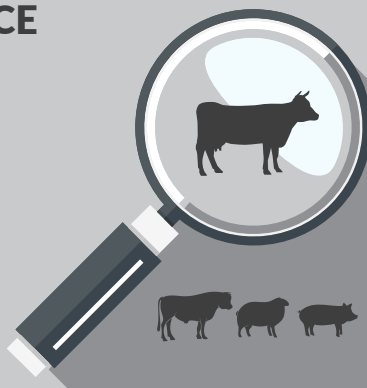

Lambs; ALL IN AVG £120!! In September. A nice show of 1600 Lambs forward today and a massive improvement in meat with the best finished yard of the season forward. More Buyers at ringside with old friends returning to the fold. Meat the key and well chased. Sadly Exporters stood twiddling their Thumbs and unable to strike in buying today with Returns on the Continent slow. Those serving the Home trade and Cutting Lambs to Export much more buoyant and creating a trade SQQ of 267p/kg equivalent of 568p/kgdw!!! Spec weight lambs today topping at 330p/kg at 43kg for Beltex from R Richins, Oxford with 38kg to 321p/kg for the same. P F Edwards 38kg to 318p/kg. Woody selling 41kg Beltex to 312p/kg and 42kg to 310p/kg. Julian White and CR Hill also breaking the 300p/kg barrier. Export Lambs with meat 270-280p/kg for first cross to Mules with leaner first cross 250 - 265p/kg. Better bred sorts regularly 280-300p/kg. Weight again the order of the day and Buyers for weighted lambs twice as many as Export weights. Topping at 48kg for 308p/kg C R Hill down from Leicestershire whom also sold 50kg to 304p/kg whilst Dabba Mitchell 51.5kg to 297p/kg. C R Hill 50kg to 288p/kg also. Weighted meat regularly 260-270p/kg with lean 250p/kg plus throughout. The all in avg a marvellous return for the time of year. Export weight lambs topping at £142 for 43kg for R Richins selling to RG Tuckey Quality Butchers, Messrs Woodwards headed off to Belgium at 44kg or £131 and R Richins £131 at 45kg bound for London. Plenty of Export weights today breaking £120 mark. Weight the top figure though and farming conditions favourable. Top today £161 for kg from H L Goode & Son with Jake Mitchell 60kg at £159 and R Jarvis 60kg to £154. HS Underwood & Son 63kg to £154. PC & RA Nichols, BF Humphrey & Son, R Richins, J Boulton and C R Hill all breaking £150 mark also. Meat is the key and today the first real show of this handsomely rewarded.

Goats; A phenomenal trade throughout for DS & LE Wadland selling to 315p/kg down to 314p/kg for Boer Goats 35 to 39kg. Topping at £123 and £122.

Young Cattle kicked us off to a serious start when the Herbert Family sold their grass only 8-9 month old Simmentals. Usually sold in the Suckled Calf Sale this wonderful run of bone and scope shown early as the Family make a move over Offa's Dyke to start farming in Brecon. A proper send off for this young farming Family whom sold 8 month old Steers at £1000 and others £940 at 9 months. Well done them and good luck. We thank the Herberts for their Custom over the years. Messrs Hemming in next down from Solihull with an Artic full. The first draw the younger Cattle seeing £1135 for Blue Steers 12 months of age with sisters £1085 and other Steers £1000. A 15month old Blue Steer to £1350 and Angus Bucket Steers 11 months to £900. Angus with size and frame from W S Harrison, Daventry next seeing a top of £1205 at 15 months with others £1150, £1100 and £1095 and the others either side of £1000. Messrs Hem Co Farming then with the older proportion of Bucket Cattle saw 15m Blue Steers to £1375 and £1275 others £1135 and sisters 17m to £1280. Limousin Steers to £1100 15m and Heifers 17m to £1185. Genuine Store cattle shown ready to start feeding and a testament to Calves from Montbeliarde Cows. Cornwall calling next with Willersey Down piggybacking the RJB Train to show a lovely run of Hill bred Store Cattle. Yearling Limousin Steers set off at £1180 and 10m to £1150. Charolais Steers 12m to £1185 and Shorthorn x Galloway £1000. Bedfordshire next represented by GC James & Co with TB4 Lincoln Reds 18m Steers to £1270. RJB next and Charolais Steers to £1230 at 17m and £1195 with Limousin £1190 and £1150. 24m old Angus Heifers to £1200. Then to round the day off the only proper yarding Cattle from A Neary, Solihull selling to £1440 for Blue Steers 24m with Herefords to £1400. Many more needed and Yarding Cattle in highest demand with a shortage of age Nationally.

Support those that Support us!..... £975 Raised. .3 The Annual Ewe Lamb Sale competing for the Modulamb Perpetual plate saw a nice yarding of Suffolk Ewe Lambs, but as is the trend less numbers year on year as the Residual Value of Fat Lambs makes the Premium on Ewe lambs a harder and harder goal to achieve. This year it was very much achieved with trade flying and an all in Avg of £137 for a yarding of mainly running lambs. Our Judge this year Mr John & Mrs Claire Salmon of Newquay, Cornwall. Our Thanks to the Salmon's for their time and expertise. We list the results below for completeness;

Suffolk Ewe Lambs in major demand with the Champions topping. These long striking Headed Lambs full of growth and potential and finding massive interest with South versus North competing for the blood. Lambs in general perhaps not as strong as in previous years which is mirrored in the fat lambs as the grass seems to be washing lambs out. Trade though more than making up for it. Topping Lambs regularly £145 to £158 and the Champions £200. Runners regularly High £120's into the £130's. Smallest runners bottoming at £116.

Multi breed Ewe Lambs much the same comment as the Suffolks with trade if anything dearer with no 3/4bred or Similar on show. Messrs P & LA Gibbs sold Texel x to £150 to start us off before Humphrey Livestock run of 200 topped at £155 with runners £126 - £132. A J Geary sold Beltex x Cheviots with tight coats and proper blue heads to a massive £192 for pens of 20 with others £162 and £158, £155 and £154. This good family donated a Black Cheviot Ewe lamb on behalf of their friends Andy and Linda Eadon. The Lamb was first sold at £310 to the Red Lion Pub, Hellidon whom put the lamb up again to be bought at £215 by Woody and then £200 by the Champion of the day before being sold at £150 to G R Hallfield of Derbyshire. Miss S Mockler later adding £100 to the fund. Well done everyone.

Cheviot x NCM Ewe lambs then from D Gurney sold to £150 and £142 for RAE Wilson. Dutch Spotted x from I Birden took £142 and DS & LE Wadland Dutch Spotted x Beltex at £161 and £154. Trade throughout very buoyant and Vendors all leaving pleased.
