

We have really struggled for our usual quality this year but normal service renewed today with a run of lambs that whilst many only Mule x where on the whole full of meat. A super trade prevailed at 280p/kg SQQ with buyers fit for numbers from start to finish. A real trade throughout. Export lambs today with shape pretty much all over 290p/kg with plenty of premium on show as Butchers pushed the Export men. Top a massive 370p/kg at 36kg from D W Gurney & Son with Beltex. Hillside with pure Beltex indoor and shorn lambs to 356p/kg and Messrs Gurney then 350,349,344,343 & 336p/kg for his well fed and super bred sorts. Heavies with shape a real trade with only Cutting lambs harder to sell on the week with heavy Suffolks etc meeting resistance. Heavier lambs saw a top of 313p/kg for 46kg from Messrs Gurney with R H Burman 46kg to 309p/kg and S Wise 46kg to 304p/kg. An all in avg today of £123 per head despite a nice showing of Export weights. Top in the Export Gross to £151 for 44kg from Messrs Gurney selling the same £148 and 43kg at £142 with 40kg to £140. Messes Humphrey Livestock 45.5 at £138. Weight though is king in the gross with a top of £164 at 60kg for M & C Morris with £162 at 59kg from RF & J Nichols with D G Coombes at £160 equal with R F Leach. B F Humphreys & Sons £158 and Messrs Jeyes £157.
