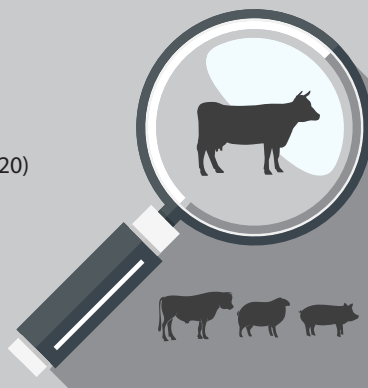

Very much a day for Farmers to beat the Forecast rain and so very few Cattle forwards. Meat in high demand throughout although a fair few grass Cattle on parade short on finish. Those finished seeing a fast trade topping at 311pkg for P Jarrom with Butchers weight Steers. Top gross £2052 for GR Fountaine & Son with Bucket Calves done to full meat from Hull Farms £2050. R Grades Steers with finish 275p/kg mark albeit 15p deduction for lack of finish.

Heifers saw more meat about and again topped by Messrs Fountaine at 324p/kg with the Jarroms 319p/kg and Mawby 314p/kg. Meat Heifers R grade or better busting through 300p/kg throughout. Top gross Grass Heifers from Messrs Lee at £1864. O Grades 270p/kg but again finish needed.

More meat needed next week when hopefully Emma returns.

Shape and finish a real trade and weight with meat without comparison. AN SQQ of 326p/kg again simply flying. Top today meat weight and shape from DS & LE Wadland on two occasions with 44kg at 389p/kg. Queen of Market Harborough S M Ellingworth saw Texel shape at 38kg to 378p/kg equalling the Prince J Barnett for 38kg. Weight and meat from MJ Woodward 43kg at 377p/kg. Export meat selling regularly 320p/kg plus with lean lambs around the 300p/kg and only the very poor under. Heavies a flyer topping at 46kg for 378p/kg for Wayne Bartlett using the M40 to best advantage. Messrs Wadland at 48.5kg 368p/kg with PM Wilks 46kg at 358p/kg. Meat throughout 340p/kg plus with heavies almost all over 320p/kg. In the lump Export lambs to a trade that made David smile.. what more can I say. David Wadland 44kg on two occasions at £171 with the same selling 45kg at £164.50 and 45.5kg £163 with MJ Woodward 43kg to £162. Weight and shape though the perfect formula returning £196 at 56kg for W Bartlett. K Attfield 61kg to £194 equalled by Stuart Brodie with 67kg at £194 and £190. Messrs Attfield and Wood also breaking £190. Meat the key and simply put Lambs short on meat best fed with the trade returning every bit of feeding.
