A few more about with 2600 Hoggs. We did have a few more booked in then materialised. Those on parade well rewarded with a below average yarding returning an SQQ of 216p/kg including 180 Mule and Swaledale wethers from away. Trade again blistering and buyers keen to fill orders whilst the trade allows for a workable margin. No real show stopping Hoggs on show and very few Hoggs to grade over an R today. In the Euro section a top of 244p/kg for 40kg Lleyns from P & S Neville with overnight bellied Hoggs. M V Hicks showed Blue Texels to 234p/kg for 43kg whilst D P Mitchell. Wendy Taylor and Garfield Stephens saw 231p/kg for 39 to 42kg. Heavies topping at 242p/kg from SM & CR Collinswood with 50kg Charollais. K Crabtree 233p/kg for 46 and 50.5kg and J Wallington, Thame 46kg to 232p/kg. Several vendors today conceding that Hoggs £3 plus dearer if bellied and dry today. Warwick Gill took the trouble to clip and sell 236 Hoggs at 47kg and Avg £100.88p. In the lump Euro Hoggs topped at 43kg and £100.50 for MV Hicks. Wendy Taylor £100 for 45kg with Warwick Gill £98 for 45kg twice in pens of 12. Weight again wanted and topping today with fed Hoggs at £132.50 for a pen of 10 66kg from J K Smith & Sons with others from the same farm £123 for 64.5kg and Garfield Stephens 60kg to £123. Smallholders Sale-17/02/2018

The production sale of in-lamb ewe lambs from Mrs M Morris, Padbury, was bolstered by a genuine reduction of in-lamb 6 tooth ewes from NF Hodges. Ewe lambs from Mrs Morris sold to £142 on 2 occasions, with the majority of pens scanning at 140%. The whole run of 168 averaged £127 and were a credit to the family. NF Hodges sold in-lamb Cheviot Mule 6 tooth ewes to top at £127, scanned with doubles to a Suffolk. Others sold to £122 and £118.

Into the smallholder section, kicking off with the poultry. Amy Wright sold Highline Pullets to £9 with A Hull matching the figure for Speckle Pullets. O Pritchett sold Khaki Campbell ducks to £10 with P Dance selling Guinea Fowl to £16 per bird. Laura Mobley sold Rabbits to £10.
