A lesser entry today and with COVID problems across the wholesale Beef sector this was by no means a bad thing. Several Abattoirs attending today and that would be all. That said, our regular buyers stood up and supported their local farmers, seeing a good trade held throughout.

Bulls-6

A mixed show of Bulls, with several Ex-Stock Bull types. Top PPK today from Alan Tacy, selling Limousin x to 196PPK, with others from the same home to 187PPK. Proper Friesians from the Dalbys to 182PPK. Top gross from Stresa Glebe Farm selling to £1325.

Steers-5

Again, mixed would be the term to describe the entry. Best end a stand on trade but the "O" grades looking serious. Top PPK today to 221PPK from CW Thomas, with South Devons to 203PPK from Richard and Judy Fountaine. Top gross to the Fountaine stable selling to £1356.

Heifers-18

A storming show of Heifers forward today. The sky the limit for the right goods. Top PPK from Parry Walters selling Limousin Heifers to 237PPK with CW Thomas selling Blues to 224PPK. Top gross for a real corker from Parry Walters selling to £1448. "O" grades looking dearer on the week, trading between 190 and 200PPK.

Cows-5

Only one FABBL cow again today, however, cows looking a strong trade. Top PPK from John Peebles selling showy Blue x to 130PPK, with Simmental x from Greyhound Estates to 129PPK. Top gross to £976 from the Peebles stable. Stock Bulls to £1206 from EA Hull, Essex.

Very few Continental x Bulls forward today, with best end Continental x Heifers trading to £245 for Simmental x Heifers from Phil Dyson and Blues to £220 from the same home. Rearing sorts £80-£140.

The remainder of the rearing calves then made up solely of Dairy x Bulls. These again a sticky trade, with the best end meeting good enquiry, topping at £61 from R Jones and Son, with the majority £25-£35.

Reared Calves a similar affair, with the best end selling to £298 for 4 month Hereford x Heifers from Leam Farm Partnership, with the rest being Dairy x types. Friesians sold to £120 from AC & MT Bentley.

SPRING LAMBS: 1886 FORWARD SQQ 203 P/KG

Just under 1900 today to meet a hard trade throughout with orders few and far between. A full two tier trade throughout with best end lambs trading well past 2.30p/kg whilst the large number of over fat or undercooked lambs a harder trade. An Sqq of 203p/kg amongst the top in the country but trade hard throughout. The divide between qualities becoming very wide as kill out percentages fall with best end Exporters undeterred by price in favour of quality. Smart Beltex the top three spots today from Oxfords own R Richins selling to 287, 278 and 271p/kg for 41.5kg,41kg and 40kg. Ben Nichols showing quality at 41kg also at 40kg. Smart shape for the returning S Collie saw 34.5kg to 267p/kg and M Sallis, Sapcote saw 38kg 259p/kg. B Burton of Banbury, RHE Levinge of London, GR Fountaine & Son of Milton Keynes and TH Morris & Sons, Crick all breaking the 250p/kg mark. Todays averages notably knocked by the very fat lambs on offer as well as a reluctance to purchase basic Export lambs 43 to 47kg.

In the heavies a top ppk of 237p/kg for Holly Levinge bringing shape up from London ahead of 219p/kg at 47kg from John Elkington and 218p/kg with Edward Hull up from Essex to 217p/kg at 48kg. All in todays yarding averaged exactly £90. In the lump Export lambs coming back at £119 for 41.5kg from R Richins and £115 for 45kg from GR Fountaine & Son with £114 for R Richins and B Burton. Heavies a harder sell with Covid lockdowns casting a shadow on Wholesalers and Caterers. Top £113 at 65kg from R J Batchelor with 46kg £110 from Messrs Levinge, B Wakeham, Ollie Pritchett and Poulson & Co, Market Bosworth. Trade sticky no one can deny but Pandemic forces are providing understandable uncertainty on Wholesalers. We all hope its over soon.

Top this week a trio of Rams to £134 for Texels from RFS Ltd, Suffolk. Shaped Charollais Ewes from Jim Wallis to £130 and AL & AR Wolfe £120 for Texel Ewes with Charollais from Jim Wallis the same money. Texel x Mules well supported today with Lennox Doyle Farms Ltd up from the South to £116. Rows of white headed ewes over £100 this week. Strong Suffolks on display this week and not the fat we have seen in past weeks taking £113 for F Hodgkin with £103 for RAE Wilson and £102.50 from RFS ltd. Suffolks almost all over £90 and trading generally £95 mark. Mules today to £82.50 from R E Tustian with £81.50 from RAE Wilson and the generality of Mules £72 to £76. Grazing Ewes a continued strong trade. Fat the real Issue with many Ewes discounted £30 as a result.
