Prime Lambs: 2212 forward SQQ 183p/kg

A bumper crop today as lambs travelled from Herefordshire and Brighton to show a yard over 2200. A trade as predicted showing smart lambs and those under 45kg to be a swift trade returning possible the days highest SQQ of 183p/kg whilst heavy lambs more selective. Good meated heavy lambs still wanted but lean and shapeless heavy lambs frankly a commodity over supplied and with limited outlets. In the Euro section lambs today topping at 211p/kg for one of the last pens sold to Norman Deeley seeing 39.5kg at 211p/kg ahead of Stuart Gowling at 210p/kg for 39kg and Messrs Claridge 206p/kg for 43kg. D Hopcraft, R woodward, T E Payne & Son, Stuart Gowling again and Norman Deeley again all breaking the 200p/kg barrier. 215 lambs today trading over 190p/kg. In the heavies a top ppk of 204p/kg for 46kg from Norman Deeley whilst Stuart Gowling 194p/kg for 46.5kg whilst 47kg 191p/kg from Humphrey Livestock. In the lump Euro lambs topping at £91.50 for 45.5kg from Stuart Gowling with R & B Smith £89 for 45kg and £88.50 for 43kg from AEJ & FJ Claridge. Heavies with meat still a good price topping today at £105.50 for R & B Smith with 70kg Texels whilst R F Wilson £102 and £101.50 for pens of 10 at 61kg. Angela Tarry- Smith, £97.50 at 60kg and G Morgan, Hereford £96.50 for 56kg. Trade today very honest. Good sheep a good trade and dying at 3.85 to 3.95 deadweight comparison.
