A record number through RFM for the month of March with another 348 Sold this week. An awful day for weather and those thinking about Turn out with some very glum faces. Starting with Grazing Cows A H Oliver & Sons sold Angus Cows £1185 and £1130.

A good feeding Bull Section next when RF Leach sold a run of 18 Beef Shorthorn Bulls 10-12m of age. This good run topped at £1160 and £1135 and avg all in £1076 finding homes from Southam to Loughborough across to Hereford and down to Mid Wales.

Young Cattle from Cummins & Bickford saw £810 at 9 months for Limousin. 11 month Limousin Heifers with style from RJB saw a top of £1200, £1170 and £1160. Charolais out of Galloway Cows all outliers from H Douglass saw a top of £880 at only 10m with plenty £830 and sisters to £835. Herefords from DM Leedham at 12 months saw Steers to £1200. Blondes with stretch from JHB Hart down from Leicestershire saw Heifers to £1255 at 14m other £1135. The last of the Estate of Frank Badger next saw Beef Shorthorns at £995 and £965 12m of age and sisters £820. Nephew Tom keeping pace behind selling Simmentals only 11 months of age at £940 and Limousin £935. Shorthorn Heifers 11m to a massive £990.

A yarding of two qualities and a few less than expected albeit the weather putting a few off, a good yarding for a Bank Holiday. The best a real trade and anything with meat selling past 400p/ kg. Buyers for meat very fit but some Exporters showing signs of the end of Ramadan demand looming. Thankfully those that remained very fit. Best Hoggs at huge demand seeing Export Hoggs to 545p/kg, 526p/kg and 513p/kg for J & H Tustian with Beltex with this good home also 506p/ kg. Humphrev Livestock 44kg to 495p/kg. Export Meat Hoggs 400p/kg throughout for first cross meat with lean Hoggs 30p behind. Anything better bred 430p/kg continuously. Heavies no limitation to the PPK column and the top for the day 588p/kg at 51kg from Kieth Crabtree with super Beltex full of meat and presented clean and tidy. S F Taylor Beltex 48kg at 504p/kg and Amorise Farms Ltd 50kg to 480p/kg. Heavy Hoggs 380p/kg plus for weight and meat with better end easily walking past 400p/kg with meat a real bonus. Export Hoggs a serious trade in the gross topping at £218 for 44kg from Humphrey Livestock with SF Taylor 40kg £218 and J &H Tustian 40.5kg at £205 for various pens. Gross the key point and weight the key. TODAY A NEW MARKET RECORD for Commercial sheep with two separate pend from K Crabtree selling 51kg Beltex at £300 and heavier 63kg £300. S F Taylor £255 at 66kg and K Crabtree then pen after pen £245 to £250. PA & K Barnes 60kg at £245 before Amorise Farms Ltd £242 to £244. Trade simply flying for meat throughout with leaner Hoggs holding back others and some Hoggs waisted in the absence of meat.

Ramadan ends either next Tuesday or Wednesday, yet to be confirmed. Maybe one last hoorah next Monday before the job steadies.


