A useful number but only one or two nice runs on offer and the generality of the quality on show less on the week with a SQQ of 290p/kg. Signs of resistance getting harder due to a hard meat selling climate a result of a strengthening pound and Elasticity of Demand very much tested at the current level. Export weights still well chased topping at 353p/kg from P Batchelor with V J Roots 34.5kg to 348p/kg with S Oakes & Son, Derby to 344p/kg. Nice 40kg Beltex from P Batchelor to 343p/kg and 342p/kg at 38kg from J B Elkington. D W Gurney & Son 40kg to 333p/kg. Heavies chased well and shape rewarded to see S F Taylor, Coventry take 311p/kg at 48.5kg and 53kg from the same 308p/kg. The Smithy Farm Shop showing quality to 46kg at 303p/kg and H A Fricker & Sons 46kg 292p/kg. Trade topping shows some big rewards today with 40kg to £137 from P Batchelor and £137 at 44kg from V J Roots. Messrs Gurney in on the act at £133 for 40kg with J D Lombard 45kg to £130.50. Weight paying despite the endless issue of limited outlets but weight and shape a perfect combination for S F Taylor who dominated the leader board with £163 at 53kg, £155 at 60kg and £152 at 56kg. Greenfields of Twycross showed 58kg to £150.
