In the Steers a little lacking in finish and weight today but goods for goods perhaps a trade as much as 10p up on the week. A lightweight Steer from R J Grindal to 208p/kg whilst O+ grade Limousin Steers from R W Cross to £1241.

Heifers a swift go and trade to 226p/kg from R J Grindal with others from Parry Walters 221p/kg and 216p/kg. R Grades today all over 210p/kg with a top gross in the Heifers for a lightweight yarding of £1214 to Messrs Grindal.

Bulls just two Aberdeen Angus Bulls looking the trade of the day levelling at 169p/kg £1135 for Messrs Woods Farm, Meriden.

Grade 3 Cows today with weight selling to 131p/kg both for Bill Windridge and Ralph Tustian with plenty of aged Cows over 120p/kg. Top gross £1020 to Messrs Windridge.

Store Cattle: 121 forward

A good days trading in the Store Cattle albeit perhaps 50 booked in not forward due to various paperwork issues. They will come next time. In summary a trade that would be £100 up on December with best done sorts and those warm cattle directing a premium. Noticeable that the historic short turn around feeders reverting to buy younger mid-age cattle to provide a greater span of sales options.

We started well with some Suckled Calves from Ellis Partners seeing Limousin Steers at £750 at 10 months of age with others at £740 and sisters equal money. Peterborough vendors W H Robinson & Son saw Charolais x Steers at £835 8-9 months of age with Sisters to £670. Similar age Angus Steers from Messrs Merris Bros £830. Brian Parker topped the section with Charolais Steers at £910 for a pen of 5 aged 10 -11 months the same vendor taking £830 for Shorthorns. Up the ages strong grading Cattle hard done or dairy sorts harder to sell. 20 month old Simmental x from TJ Dewes £1080 with South Devons £1065. 15 month old Blondes from Townshend Partners £980 and £920. Trade of the day though for Charolais Heifers at 20 -21 months from RV Tomlinson, Market Bosworth taking £1065 for a pen full. More in a fortnight when we expect 300.

All very small dairy calves today topped at £90 for Sussex Heifers with Black and Whites to £82

Prime Hoggs: 2,645 forward SQQ 197p/kg

Just under 2650 Hoggs penned in the aisles this week to be graced by a rip roaring trade for all weights but most notably the handy weights. New vendors sending lorry loads weekly and travelling to meet a fair and consistent market with genuine competition. An SQQ of 197p/kg and overall average just shy of 190p/kg placing the live trade streaks ahead of any deadweight comparison. In the Euro Spec a competition of the Leicestershire vendors this week with Beltex from Will Moore and Dave Mitchell topping at 245p/kg at 40kg for Dave and 244p/kg for 41kg from Will. Ben Burton took 218p/kg whilst Chris Osborn travelled up from Aylesbury to take 213p/kg for 39kg. Today 365 Hoggs trading at 200p/kg or more. In the heavies a top ppk of 210p/kg for another Leicestershire man when Bob Rutter took 210p/kg at 46.5kg. Garfield Stephens kept up the trend to take 197p/kg for 47kg. In the lump the Euro section today topped at £100.20p from Will Moore whilst Dave Mitchell £98 for 40kg and Messrs Townshend Partners took £92.50 for 45kg. Overall top gross this week at £106 and £105 to Garfield Stephens at 60kg whilst Oakland College Hertfordshire took £100 for equal weights. All in all a good consistent trade, with Hoggs being bid upon based on merit and not the owners name. Long term sustanbility of the trade though seriously questioned from this Office as supply and demand determinants now take over.
