A yarding and trade to reflect the current industry. The Cattle mainly those that wouldn't hit the various required spec and the trade reflective on the merits of those Cattle with an ever decreasing end user base. Having said that quality rewarded and with actual killing percentages taken account a kill at approximately 10p more than the deadweight quote. Another new processing account at ringside and we hope the Cattle serve them well.

In the Steers no real show stoppers but good weighted Limousin Steers from R W Cross to 194p/kg with J B Baylis & Partners 186p/kg several times over. Top gross £1357 to Messrs Cross whilst weight paying for FE & CJ Barnett with Herefords to £1310 at 771kg.

Heifers a better cross section and customers all around for them with top this week to Parry Walters at 216p/kg ahead of Messrs Baylis at 214p/kg both for handyweight Limousin. Top gross though with weight and Herefords from Messrs Barnetts dairy herd to take £1214. Buyers at ringside but struggling to compete with the trade at the other end with most firms quoting little over 320p/kg.

We did start again with Cows and Cows and Calves from Messrs Calcott & Son seeing 2012 Blue Cows with 3 month Heifer Calves sell to £1350 and others £1210. In calf Cows due to calve in 6 weeks saw Blues to £1220 and £1150.

Young cattle in demand with the top end as dear as ever albeit second rates harder to sell. The sale started swiftly when J C Bostock & Son took £740 for 7 month old Charolais Heifers. 10 month old Hereford Steers took £780 for Messrs Merris Bros Farming. Strong Charolais Steers at 14 months from J S Agricultural Services took £950 for a penful. R J Wright showed Herefords to £930 at 16 months of age and Angus Steers at 17 months from F H Loggin & Sons took £980. Top of the section though a 17 month old Charolais x Holstein Steer from NJ & S Smith at £1025. 19 month old Angus Heifers from R Wright £990 whilst a pen of Charolais Steers at 22 months from Kevin Welsby £1000 with sisters £900, 21 month old Shorthorns from Messrs Hague £1020. Powerful pens of Charolais from JS Agricultural Services saw 22 month Steers at £1105 and £1100 whilst top for the day an Angus x from MR Beaty at 21 months to £1120.

Top in the section AR & J Collett selling 38.5kg Texels at 225p/kg whilst W H Allan sold Beltex Hoggs to 223p/ kg at 40kg. G Curtis & Son sold Beltex at 218p/kg for 40kg whilst Richard and Judy Fountaine took equal money for 39.5kg Beltex. Today 653 Hoggs trading at 200p/kg or more!! Miles and miles ahead of the deadweight. In the Heavies a top ppk of 226p/kg from J & H Tustian, Epwell for 46.5kg whilst the same good home took 210p/kg for 48kg and R Goodman, Thame 203p/kg for 47kg. In the lump this week Euro Hoggs topped at £92 for 45kg from Will Moore, Leicester whilst he beat the Outlaws into second place with R G Rutter, Dadlington £92 for 45.5kg. PD & C Pritchard, Stratford Upon Avon took £91.50 for 45kg Texel equal with C J Whitehead, Stowe.
