Unlike many we always aim to give concise honest reports on trade. Today Cattle frankly a commodity that were for the rows of onlookers to view and not bid upon. Confidence in the Cattle job seemingly void and continued finished prices restricting returns all through. That said quality, sure doing, Cattle still a lively trade and squeezing every inch out of margins if returns are to be assumed to be as they are today. Serious Cattle men though still bidding to what they can actually give. £880 for 10 month old Steers from J W Lowick for a pen full with younger brothers £800. Messrs Priddle travelled up from Aylesbury with a wagon full to see Simmental Steers at 11 months of age take £830 for 6 with others £800. The same homes 16 month old dairy cross Simmentals to £1000. P M Wilks. Towcester cashed some powerful Blue Steers to £1000 at 19 months with Limousin £980. Yearling Angus from the same home £840. Wendy and Sophie Taylor shown the respect they deserve to see yearling Charolais at £870 for a pen of 7. Whilst Woods Farm Meriden took Angus Heifers at 12 months to £740 for a pen full. Angus Steers from M R Beaty £995 at 14 months of age. Last in the ring C H Evans & Son saw 23 month Charolais Heifers £1000 and a marvellous Simmental Heifer £1105. The goods wanted but anything slightly less than spot on frankly almost unwanted.

Top in the section J & H Tustian showing Beltex to 231p/kg at 45kg bred by D Wadland, close behind R Randall & Son at 217p/kg for 45kg Texels with Townshend Partners 216p/kg at 43kg. 41.5kg Beltex from Pete Batchelor to 214p/kg. In the heavies a top once again to J & H Tustian with properly finished Hoggs at 225p/kg for 48kg Beltex, with 48.5kg 214p/kg and Pete Batchelor showing similar goods at 213p/kg. Bob Rutter, Market Bosworth took 211p/kg for 46.5kg Texels. In the Lump a top for the Euro section of £104 for 45kg from Henry Tustian. Charlie Randall had £97.50 for 45kg Texels and SF & AJ Deeming had £93.50 for 45kg Texels. Overall a top today from W V Harris & Son for a 74kg Charollais at £110 ahead of Steve Ronch with £109.50 for 60kg and J & H Tustian who had two pens at £106 and one at £108 to see his load of 152 Hoggs avg just a coin under £100. Today 153 Hoggs trading at £100 or more.
