SHEEP: 2,526 forward

Spring Lambs: 705 forward SQQ 213p/kg

The largest entry of new season lamb in the region this year with 700 lambs penned. A fair trade but supply this week outweighing demand perhaps. Predictions though suggest the big switch over from the Hoggs will begin next week. An SQQ 213p/kg ahead of deadweight comparison and does include 35 Cade lambs. Quality though wanted and anything with bloom trading well over 220p/kg. Top today to Dave Mitchell seeing Texels at 38kg to 242p/kg whilst M Warren, Buckingham took 230p/kg for 38kg and Angela Russell, Stratford upon Avon 38kg Beltex at 228p/kg equal with C D Harrison at 36kg. Top gross £99 for MG & M Barnes with 50kg whilst MM Clarke & Sons £96 for 46kg and Charles Harding showing Suffolks at £95 for 45kg. Trade will need to be taken on a region by region basis with some areas lambs remaining a novelty whilst others demand is yet to catch numbers. Plenty of power here though in the buying aisles awaiting the word to buy.

A good yarding of Hoggs for a Bank Holiday with 1300 plus penned. Buyers weary and large Hoggs in plentiful supply. Good spec Hoggs though required and an SQQ of 190p/kg absolutely on fire in comparison to alternative deadweights. In the Euro Spec section a top today to G Doyle, Shipston on Stour with 43kg Texels to 205p/kg whilst Frank Osbourne, Northampton 204p/kg for 38kg and Richard Heckford 34kg to 200p/kg equal with George Scrivens, Hereford. In the heavies a top of 191p/kg to Stuart Friswell at 46kg whilst Frank Osbourne took 190p/kg for 46kg and R Deeley 189p/kg at 47kg. In the Euro lump, top today Messrs Doyle at £88 for 43kg with G Scrivens £86 for 43kg and Frank Osbourne £85 for 45kg. Overall top a smart Blue from PD & DM Hopcraft at £106 with R Randall £96.50, £96 x2 and £95.50 for 60kg and D P Mitchell £96 for 65kg.
