Sheep theft and in-field butchery in Northamptonshire meeting with Police 31 May

The incidence of sheep theft has slowly risen across the county in recent years. Circa 50 incidents have been reported to the Police involving either sheep theft or the in-field butchery of sheep.

This letter is to invite you, as a sheep producer, to a meeting with the Northamptonshire Police being held at the Compton Estate Club in Castle Ashby village on Tuesday 31 May at 7.30pm.

The aim of this meeting will be to raise awareness of the issue and scale of the problem and discuss how we can help the Police going forward. What steps can farmers take to reduce this type of crime? What level of publicity is appropriate? How do we improve reporting of incidents to the Police? What more is there we can do to help the Police? What more can they do to help us?

I recently saw a report from Warwickshire that 5 individuals have been caught stealing sheep so it is possible to apprehend and prosecute the culprits. In Northamptonshire we will consider organising publicity around this meeting to put a marker down with those responsible for our incidents that the farming community is making a more concerted effort to thwart their plans. We can also seek the help of the public to report anything suspicious around your fields or if offered cheap lamb.

I look forward to seeing sheep producers on the 31 May to initiate improved Police liaison on this issue and come up with a plan to tackle the issue.
