### Breeding Cattle Sale including a Sale of Ewes with lambs at foot on Saturday 14th May

In the inaugural Spring Breeding Sale a strong trade and following was witnessed for all breeds both by Pedigree breeders and commercial users alike. This fixture saw special section for Beef Shorthorn Cattle privately arranged by the Mart. The Beef Shorthorn section included a show for the 69 cattle forward, judged by Roger Elliott, Kislingbury. Mr Elliotts choice as Champion, the Maiden Heifer, Plynlimon Wheat (H) this top 5% EBV Heifer bred by Christopher Evans, Herefordshire went on to sell to 2450 Guineas with the Balgay Elden daughter out of Ballylinney Wheat 1025 going to Messrs Fenemore, Buckinghamshire. Fast trade also for an incalf heifer from Brenda Wear, Bristol showing Redhill F Eva Broadhooks 101, this two year old daughter by Redhill Felton sold pd'd in calf for November at 2200 Guineas the choice of M Moss for his Uxbridge herd . Reserve Champion Greenley Joyful June, a 16 month maiden heifer sired by Chapleton Winsome out of the Podehall Joyful April consigned by Graham Towers made 1950 Guineas to Robert Leach of Warmington, Banbury.

The sale also included a draft sale (mainly out wintered heifers) from James and Tina Fanshawe's Lucombe herd, one of the largest herds of Beef Shorthorns in the UK, which sold to 1220 Guineas. The ringside was full of pedigree and commercial buyers with interest for all grades. Auctioneer, Tom Wrench commented "The level of entry for a first time venture was very pleasing. That the yarding provided something for everyone ensured the full ringside was catered for be it Commercial users or those looking for specific bloodlines to enhance established Herds."

In the other breed sections a good showing of females throughout. Incalf Simmental Heifers from the Wroxall Herd topped at 1780 Guineas for Wroxall Fifi-Primrose a Tiset Darwin daughter, sold due to calve for the first time in November, Fifi was the choice of C Tucker, Devizes, Wiltshire. Wroxall Fruitella-Primrose a pier of Fifi, Sired by Pasturefields Turbo Tommy took 1600 Guineas to Messrs Windridge, Coventry.

Simmental Cow and Calf units from the Peatling Herd topped at 1680 Guineas for the 2013 Peatling Ellie a Chyanhal Wellington daughter with her 2month old Storersmith Einstein Bull Calf selling to Messrs Barnes, Rugby.

Commercal aged Cows and Calves sold to £1390 for 9 year old Limousin Cows and Store Cattle to £855 for 11 month old Beef Shorthorn Steers.

Shorthorn Averages: halter trained 2 year old heifers £1828, yearling heifers £1571 and 2 year old bulls £1585. Production draft from the Lucombe herd 2 year old heifers £918.

#### **Ewes and Lambs**

A nice show of Ewes and Lambs and plenty of men in the aisles. Two different trades though today with Mule Tegs with Lambs at foot a flying trade but Continental Sheep very hard to fix especially those lacking size. In the Mule Ewe lambs Will Allen topped the day selling strong Ewe Lambs with Texels at foot to £92 and £90 per life whilst Andrew Geary travelled up from Milton Keynes to take £88 and £87 per life for Mule outfits. Strong Texel Ewe Lambs with singles sold to £74 per life from Barton Farms whilst 4 tooth Suffolks with twins from Holly Weaver sold to £70 or £210 per outfit.

Frankly an awful trade on the week with buyers having no interest whatsoever. Seemingly no retail or wholesale trade about and an SQQ of 194p/kg just about in line with others albeit most comparisons having a lot less lambs in the aisles. Better end lambs still wanted and Euro Spec lambs selling to 232p/kg for 38kg Texels from M Thornber with Chris Osborn to 231p/kg at 39kg whilst Will Gaydon showed 40kg at 215p/kg. In the lump a top of £104 for M Thornber whilst M Cheney had £98. Lamb trade needing monitoring. Deadweight quotes very good on paper but it remains to be seen this week if they will be able to sustain these.

In the lump a top of £131 for Tups weighing 76kg from R Woodward with 64kg brothers £101. David Ofield £99 for 75kg and Messrs Tombs £98 for 68kg. Days now surely numbered for Tegs.
