#### SHEEP: 3,797 forward

#### Spring Lambs: 2,044 forward SQQ 206.68p/kg

The largest entry of the year despite the Bank Holiday with over 2000 met an SQQ top of the tree for the national returns and up on the week at just shy of 207p/kg. The second week in a row saw a new buyer in the aisles as major outlets move to those centres with the required numbers of supply. Trade quick throughout especially for lightweight thick lambs and trade honestly, in advance of predictions or outlooks for the sector. In the Euro section a top PPK of 240p/kg for a pen of 30kg Charollais from A Mobley, Henley whilst D & GM Wright had 231p/kg for 38.5kg Texels and S Wise 229p/kg for 39kg. Today just under 200 lambs trading at 220p/kg plus. In the heavies a top ppk of 207p/kg for 45kg from MM Clarke & Sons whilst Gordan Emery had 200p/kg for 46kg equal with IPG Farms. In the lump Euro Lambs topped at £94.50 for 44kg from T W Spokes with Charollais and with the same money and description RP Gregory. MM Clarke & Sons took £93 for 45kg and R & B Smith, Slapton £92.50 for 42kg. Overall topped this week for F J Tombs & Son, Aylesbury taking 57kg to £106 and R Randell & Son 59kg at £101. J & R Lowe topped the consignment of 180 from Rugby at £98 for 50kg. Trade must be monitored this week as the Euro continues to rise on the pound and Ramadan fasting commences across Europe this week. Please call to discuss.
