Store Cattle: 167 forward

A nice show of Store Cattle today saw buyers from across the country and new buyers to this ring making their presence felt. We started with Breeding Cattle seeing a 2010 Limousin Stock Bull to £1500 whilst an Aberdeen Angus Bull, Harrison Pytchley from Messrs Whitehead 2013 born took £1700. Into the Stores and a raise in trade of the bucket reared sorts with Black and Whites from J Rutter to £300 at 6 months which followed the trade lift through to the Continental breeds. A Davenport & Son showed Limousin Steers at £900 for a pen full at 11 months of age with the Angus Brothers taking £805. A grand run of 46 from A North & Sons, Lower Quinton showed real class 15 month old Limousin Steers at £1180 with others £1165 and £1110 and 15 month old Heifers at £1120 and £1045. The load of 46 avg £1056 and a credit to his family. So as to show quality all up the ages Messrs A North & Sons topped the day at £1200 for 19 month old Limousin Steers for a pen full. Whilst a pen full of Sisters found new homes in Worcester at £1195. Limousin Steers from A J Breakspear saw a pen at £1000 for 17 months of age and N & S Staines, Leicester took Angus Steers to £1040 at 22 months of age. Another good days trading.

#### SHEEP: 3,073 forward

#### Spring Lambs: 1,140 forward SQQ 204.3p/kg

A smaller than usual yarding as farmers assess the lamb trade but still 1140 lambs today met an increased SQQ at 205p/kg and as the deadweight quotes drop the markets rise. Quotes last week perhaps a Sprat to catch a Mackerel? Plenty of trade here today with a new customer travelling from the North for sheep. Lightweights in major demand and weighted sheep now finding some following as the Tegs dry. In the Euro section a top ppk today for Stuart Wise selling 40kg Texels at 231p/kg ahead of Hillside Farm who showed 35kg Texels at 229p/kg and Barton Farms similar goods at 228p/kg. Mid spec Texels from Hillside Farm 39kg at 226p/kg and 41kg and 39kg from Mark Lambert to 226p/kg and 223p/kg. In the heavies, strength from Bernhard Labram saw 48kg at 208p/kg and 62kg 203p/kg whilst 46kg from SA & E Friswell 202p/k. In the lump Euro lambs topped today at £95 for 45kg from Alan Boffey whilst Stuart Wise sold 42.5kg at £93 and 40kg at £92.50. Overall a top of £126 for 62kg from B W Labram & Sons with others at 48kg £100. MM Clarke & Sons £97.50 for 49kg. Lambs looking a good shot and at last weeks yard kill of 47% equal to 434p/kg dead, no grid.

Still well over 1200 Hoggs today meeting a trade that for the meat was on fire with only the very poor stragglers harder to sell. A new large use account wanting the meat and trade throughout. SQQ 172.2p/kg looking a wonderful return with few Hoggs in the weight band carrying any finish at all. Top of the Euro class lightweight Hoggs from Frank Osborne at 30kg to 200p/kg whilst D W Gurney 193p/kg for 40kg and J A H Busby 40kg at 183p/kg. In the heavies super meat from Sarah Denne to 196p/kg for 47kg and 188p/kg for 48.5kg to R Randall & Son whilst Nigel Chantry saw 51kg to 186p/kg. Overall a top of £119 for V M Bailey, Mixbury selling 74kg whilst Stuart Warden, Fillongley £106.50 for 66kg and White Bros, Grendon £105.50 for 66kg Texels. R Deeley £100 for 55kg and equal with Nigel Redfern. Hoggs seemingly wanted and perhaps now is the time to clear them off the farm.
