An SQQ of 188p/kg one of the highest for the day and an indication of the numbers out across the country. In the Euro Spec a top of 221p/kg for Dave Mitchell with 39kg whilst Martin Woodward 218p/kg for equal weights whilst D Mitchell 217p/kg for 42kg. In the heavies R J Batchelor 188p/kg for 48.5kg whilst FJ Tombs & Son 187p/kg twice for 46.5 kg.In the lump a top for the Euro lambs at £91 for 42kg for D Mitchell, £87 for 43kg Texels from Julian White and equal money for 45kg for RM Seckington & Son. 
Two pens of rare breed Store Hoggs today, with a top of £61 for C Sander. We now look towards the new crop with Store lambs likely to come about as we look to July.


