Another bustling yarding of lambs with well over 3300 penned and sold today with vendors travelling from far and wide. Que kept to a minimum too although we are always looking for ways to make the liveweight system as convenient as possible. Trade though indescribably fast with new buyers at ringside and lambs bid for as though they were the last lambs available. Trade today levelling just shy of 217p/kg a marvellous trade with vendors taking full weight on every lamb. In the Euro section today a two way tie between S J Lacey and R & R Knowles both showing 39kg at 228p/kg for Texel and Beltex. R M Seckington, Banbury took 227p/kg for 42.5kg equal with C R Sercombe, Frisley on the Wreake for 43kg. At 227p/kg also Jamie Whatton of RS Whatton & Son for 40.5kg Texels. Messrs Whatton showing consistence up the weights to see 50kg at 223p/kg whilst W & M Emery had 216p/kg for 46kg Charollais and Humphrey Livestock equal money for 47kg. Whilst Phillip Abbott, Tamworth 215p/kg for 46kg equal with young Sam Gibbs. Today just a pen short of 1000 lambs trading at 220p/kg or better!! Gross total today in the Euro weights today joint topped by RM Seckington & Sons and Dave Mitchell at £99 for 44.5kg whilst Phillip Abbott had £99 for 45kg lambs. Overall top spots in first and second place today Jamie Whatton at £112 for 53.5kg and £111.50 at 50kg. W M Emery and Upton Mill Farm both £111 and £110 for JW & BA Deacon at 51kg. A trade not seen in July before that should be seen as a bonus by those marketing lambs. Caution though should be taken in regards to the factors leading to the rise in trade which can of course be reversed at a moments notice. Also please do note that lambs with finish are hotly contested but do not rush lambs as buyers are still wary of quality.

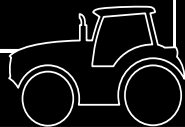
