A small show out in the sun met a trade to beat any this year with Butchers clearly anticipating some demand as the fair English skin enjoys its 72 hours in the Sun.

Steers from Richard and Judy Fountaine saw a Blonde meet spirited demand to fall at 206p/kg and with weight £1508.

Butchers Heifers wanted and provided today with a better quality on show then has been seen for a while. J B Baylis & Partners to 221p/kg whilst the now famous Parry Walters 220p/kg. Weight though paying and Messrs Fountaine again top of the tree with 206p/kg and £1352.

Just a pair of aged Black and White Bulls met a marvellous trade for Holsteins at nearly 700kg selling at 143p/kg and £990.

A lot of overage today mostly store Steers and Heifers around the 50 months mark saw Heifers to £1051 from R Wilkinson. Cows again the order of the day albeit grade 3 Cows a little easier than the last few weeks. A super heavy South Devon from R Ellis to 130p/kg returning £1330.

Store Cattle: 46 forward

A fair few less than catalogued as vendors chose to make Hay etc. Wrong choice!! Trade off the clock for the goods on show with Cattle perhaps £100 dearer than seen this year like for like. Top of the tree a consignment of Angus Steers from Messrs Dilks, Weedon seeing his load average over £1100 with 21 month old Angus Steers to £1180 whilst others £1100, £1090 and £1080. Younger stores saw 18 months from Messrs Bevin to £900 for South Devon Steers whilst Wolverton Estate saw Hereford bucket reared at 15 months to £845 on numerous occasions.

SHEEP: 4,188 forward

Spring Lambs: 3,756 forward SQQ 192p/kg

Numbers up again today as lambs travel to Stoneleigh. Customers met a steadier trade as the Exchange Rate and European festivities steady the job a little. Trade though consistent and above the days National trade at just shy of 192p/kg. Comment must be made that an abundance of lean lambs and under-weight lambs forward today that ordinarily have a niche market at this time of year. Supply though nationally of this commodity now outweighs demand and vendors are advised to draw lambs above 40 kg for best returns and buying audience. Euro Spec lambs today selling to 213p/kg for JS & VM Hiorns selling 39kg to £83. Stuart Gowling took 208p/kg for 39kg and Jeff Clarke Beltex at 207p/kg for 33.5kg and in total 150 lambs over 200p/kg today. In the heavies a top ppk to Newfields Horse Stables at 196p/kg for 46kg whilst MM Clarke & Sons 195p/kg for 45.5kg and JMT Engineering 195p/kg for 46kg. in the lump Euro lambs today topped at £89 for 45kg from Andrew Seckington with Bob Rutter £88 for 44kg and BC Burton £88 for 45kg. Overall a super heavy Ram lamb from S Dunkley at £105 with Trevor Atkins £99 for 52kg equal with Boulton Bros and Messrs Leadbeater Texels at £98 for Charollais at 53kg. Lambs trade must be monitored but likely now to look to find a sustained level of trading subject to further Exchange fluctuations. Meat and finished lambs though look to be meeting some very good returns.

Store lamb season will start any time soon and despite buoyancy in the fat lambs, stores today would per kg come to more than the fat lambs as farmers look to risk feeding to the trade.

Trade stronger again and Ewes really are retaining a prolonged period of buoyancy nationally. Top today for a pen of Texels from DJ & BJ Leadbeater taking £120 for power whilst Messrs Fountaine £112 and Stuart Dunkley £100 for Charollais. Texel x From C D Harrison to £100 with more from the Leadbeater stable at the same money. Top Suffolks to £97 from SF & AJ Deeming with Barford Grounds Estates Holding Company at £94. Mules wanted today just so long as no fat present and Messrs Barford Holdings again topping this section at £88 with Messrs Fraser £87.We include all Ewes in the averages and perhaps the smaller rare breeds and Hills sheep the dearest pound for pound today with Mank sheep to £56 with Welsh Mountains to £56.
