Heifers as ever wanted and plenty of handyweights here today selling to 224p/kg for P Jarrom ahead of CW Thomas at 223p/kg with others from P Jarrom at 219p/kg. Top gross £1284 to Messrs Jarrom ahead of PC & R Nichols & Son at £1253.

A suckler bred calf from Rich Smith ringing the bell at £320 for a Simmental x heifer, with Mrs Trice hot on his heels with British Blue x heifer calves at £305 and £302. Black and whites from Trice again selling well to £111, with Sussex x from Border Holdings to £52. More calves needed each and every week with trade like this.

SHEEP: 2,470 forward

Prime Lambs: 1,425 forward SQQ 189p/kg

The smallest yarding of the year so far as producers struggle to find meat, and in truth some of those in the aisles today perhaps being killed before they are ready. Trade though frankly unbelieveable. We did expect a slow in trade in line with the end of last week, but none of it. An Sqq only 1p less than the weeks before representing a increase in trade with a yarding of sheep incredibly lean on the whole.

In the Euro spec lambs a top today of 214p/kg for J & S White Farms Ltd at 40kg ahead of Di Hopcraft at 211p/kg at 38kg. J & S Whites meated Texels then also 210p/kg at 39kg and BC Burton 206p/kg x3 for 44kg. Today 150 lambs trading over the magic 200p/kg mark. In the heavies a top ppk of 196p/kg for 50kg whilst J R Hodgkinson 47kg at 194p/kg. 52kg from D Fountain at 194p/kg whilst first time vendor F Hodgkin 193p/kg at 54kg. In the lump Euro spec lambs topping at £90.50 x 2 for B C Burton at 44kg, with others 44kg at £90. Heavies still making the three figure mark. Top today £104 for 54kg from F Hodgkin. D Fountain £101, Mr Hodgkin £100 again and Messrs Poulson Market Bosworth £98 for 50kg. Trade well ahead of expectaions and lambs at 189p/kg @46% equate to 4.11p/kg dead. Producers though must ensure that they are sending meated lambs. Too many lambs currently painfully lean and best in the Stores.

Please draw meat and finish and the number of buyers at ringside will do the rest. .



HEART OF ENGLAND LLEYN SALE - Saturday

The first Heart of England Lleyn sale attracted an entry of 221 females and 17 rams.

MV accredited Theaves topped at 180 guineas from Wallace and Josie Mccurdie, with his next four pens in a marvelous run taking 175, 172, 170 and 161 respectively. JR Hadley showed commercial non-MV Texel x Lleyn Theaves to £148 for powerful sheep, with Brooksby college's pen full chasing behind at 130 guineas for pure Lleyns. The college went on to sell MV accredited ewe lambs to 92 guineas, with MR Proudley, Doncaster, close behind at 90 guineas. Solvein LTD, Oxford showed a run of shorn ewe lambs to top at £90 and look a touch, to average £86. Lleyn rams a more difficult sell but none-the-less topping at 325 guineas for a Shearling from Mr Mccurdie, with AP Liggin's selling a huge Shearling to 275 guineas and TP Radford coming down from Grantham to sell his Shearling to 240 guineas. A good start to a new venture that we hope to repeat over the next few years.
