Top gross though for a weighted Bullock at £1480 from PC & RA Nichols ahead of TR & MP Foss, Northampton at £1440. Meat the order of the day but not enough meated goods on offer. A lot of heavy store cattle available today and buyers all over for them. Heifers quite simply electrifying today with the best quality for some time meeting a near on fight of Butchers trying to buy. Top ppk today for Henry Tustian showing real shape at 244p/kg and 230p/kg ahead of P C Nichols at 229p/kg. R Grades all over 200p/kg and frankly streaks ahead of the dead. Just under 3000 albeit we did have another 400 or so booked in that did not get here. They will kick themselves for missing it. Trade simply electric with demand all around and throughout the weights, albeit the heavier lambs still demanding the greatest buying audience. Another account at ringside and an SQQ of 194p/ kg all in looking a marvellous do at a deadweight comparison of 4.21p/kg. In the Euro weight lambs today no real specialist U or E grade lambs, selling though to 206p/kg from M Peebles at 4kg with Tim Youngs 42.5kg at 204p/kg and Wendy Taylor 204p/kg for 45kg. Messrs Baylis Partners, Buckingham 203p/kg for 41kg. The heavies an unbelievable trade today with the new buyer taking 48kg from W Haynes & Son to 204p/kg for 48kg whilst lambs that had been brought in to the market the night before from B C Burton seeing 46kg at 202p/kg. Humphrey Livestock then 200p/kg for 48.5kg,49.5kg and 50kg whilst E J Taylor 200p/kg for 46.5kg. In the lump a top Euro section of £92 for 45kg from Wendy Taylor whilst B C Burton £90 for 45 and 45.5kg equal with MM Clarke & Son x2 and C D Harrison. Overall a top today of £109.50 for 60kg from S & J Farming, Brackley with W Haynes & Son £106 and £103.50 for 57 and 54kg. Today 112 lambs trading at £100 or more. 
